Southampton Anaesthetic Service (SAS) breeze through the logistical challenge of 60 individuals, 4 locations and 100 lists a month

Introduction

- Southampton Anaesthetic Service (SAS) is a group of independent consultant anaesthetists.
- Individual anaesthetists work in University Hospital Southampton NHS Foundation Trust and local independent hospitals across Hampshire.

The story of SAS

At the time of publishing, SAS consisted of 63 individual consultants that cover all areas of anaesthetic practice. The locations they work at include Nuffield Health Wessex Hospital, Spire Southampton Hospital, Sarum Road Hospital and Optegra Eye Hospital Hampshire.

Together they perform over 100 lists a month.

The very nature of SAS as an organisation poses a huge logistical challenge: coordinating over 60 independent individuals across multiple locations and 100 lists every month. Before engaging with MCH Anaesthetics, valuable hours were being wasted on inefficient and costly management processes.

SAS decided to work with MCH because the Anaesthetics product was built specifically for anaesthetists in collaboration with anaesthetists.

Time was spent ensuring that the detailed working processes of the group and the hospitals were taken into account. This has meant that MCH Anaesthetics is now the only dedicated product tailored to meet the demands of this user group.
