



## INFORMATION FOR CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION (N400)

*May apply if you have been a lawful permanent resident for at least 5 years and at least 18 years old; or permanent resident for at least 3 years and at least 18 years old. To be able to have the test in another language you must be at least 50 years of age and at least 20 years with permanent resident card; or at least 55 years of age and at least 15 years with permanent resident card.*

### **YOU NEED:**

- Your legal name & other names you have used
- Social Security Number
- Date of birth and country of birth
- If parents are U.S. Citizens, the date they became citizens and certificate number
- Current marital status; if married: name of spouse, date of birth, date of marriage, SSN, PRC #, if became a U.S. Citizen date and place.
- Home address, mailing address, & telephone number
- Information about your criminal record
- Address and dates where you have lived in the past 5 years
- List of employment from the past 5 years, name, address, and dates, or if student, the name of the schools for the past 5 years, names, address, and dates
- Dates you have traveled outside of the U.S. for the past 5 years
- If you or/and your current spouse have been married before: name of ex-spouse, date of birth, date of marriage and date of divorce.
- Information about your children: name, date of birth, country of birth, PRC #, and address.
