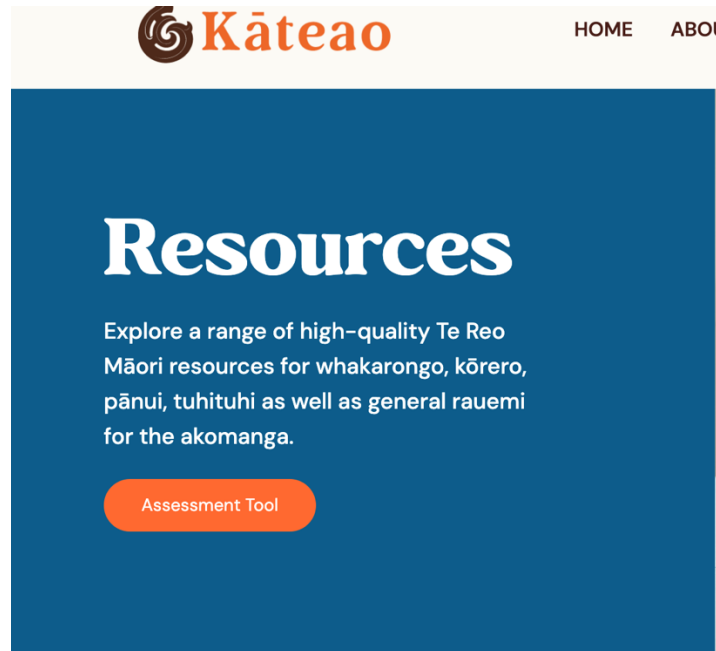


Instructions to accessing assessment tool:


Step 1:

When a user clicks on the resources tab it will take user to the resources landing page. The orange tab that says “Assessment Tool” is a link to a tracking tool to monitor and document student evidence.



Step 2:

When user clicks on “Assessment Tool” It will appear as a google sheet which encourages user to make a copy. Once a copy is made it will appear like the image below, with all whenu in the tabs at the bottom of the tracking sheet.
