

General Terms & Booking Conditions

Bivouac - Berghut Halverwege

1. Booking & confirmation

- Reservations are made by sending an email to info@cartopology.institute with your preferred dates, number of nights (maximum 2), and number of guests.
- A reservation is confirmed once you receive a confirmation email along with a payment link.

2. Rates & payment

- The rate is €34 per person per night, including tourist tax (€3.05 per person per night in 2026).
- Payment must be completed via the provided link to guarantee your booking.
- A booking is confirmed and binding after payment has been completed.

3. Check-in & check-out

- Check-in: from 17:00
- Check-out: by 11:00
- Late check-out is only possible upon prior agreement.

4. Accommodation details

- The bivouac is a cosy mountain hut sleeping place for 1-2 guests, located at the top of Berghut Halverwege with views of the Vaalserberg and Schneeberg.
- Facilities include electricity, heating, hot and cold running water (no shower).
- Toilet facilities are available on the ground floor of the mountain hut.
- Towels, blankets, and bed linen are included in the price.
- This is not a hotel, and guests are expected to respect the mountain hut's shared environment.
- Breakfast can be provided upon request and at an additional cost.

5. Cancellations & changes

- Cancellation more than 14 days before arrival: 50% refund.
- Cancellation within 14 days of arrival or no-shows: no refund.
- Changes to dates or number of guests are subject to availability.

6. Conduct & safety

- Guests are expected to respect the hut, surroundings, and other visitors.
- On the hut terrace, no music or sounds other than normal conversation are allowed.
- Quiet hours are observed from 22:00 to 07:00.
- No parties, loud music, or disruptive behaviour inside or outside the hut is allowed.
- Pets are not permitted unless agreed in advance.
- Guests stay at their own risk. The management is not liable for accidents, theft, or injury.

7. Liability

- Berghut Halverwege accepts no liability for personal belongings or valuables.
- Guests are responsible for any damage caused to the hut or its facilities during their stay.

8. Force majeure

- In the event of extreme weather, natural hazards, or other unforeseeable circumstances, the management reserves the right to cancel or reschedule bookings, with a full refund or alternative offer.

9. Privacy

- Guest data provided for booking is used only for the purpose of reservation and communication and is not shared with third parties.
