

General Terms & Booking Conditions Bivouac - Berghut Halverwege

1. Booking & confirmation

- To request a stay, send an email to reserveringen@berghuthalverwege.nl with your preferred date and number of guests.
- A confirmation will be sent if space is available. Since the bivouac primarily supports activities of the hut and its community, requests are considered individually.

2. Contribution

- We ask for a voluntary contribution towards upkeep and management of the hut. The amount is your own decision. If you'd like a rough indication of the actual costs of maintaining the hut, we're happy to share that information on request – purely for transparency, not as a reference amount.

3. Arrival & Departure

- Check-in from 17:00, check-out by 11:00
- Please inform us in advance if you need different arrangements.

4. Accommodation details

- The bivouac is a cosy mountain hut sleeping place for 1–2 guests, located at the top of Berghut Halverwege with views of the Vaalserberg and Schneeberg.
- Facilities include electricity, heating, hot and cold running water (no shower).
- Toilet facilities are available on the ground floor of the mountain hut.
- Towels, blankets, and bed linen are provided.
- This is not a hotel or B&B. Guests are expected to respect the mountain hut's shared environment.
- Breakfast can be arranged upon request.

5. Cancellations & changes

- We understand that plans can change. Please let us know as soon as possible if you need to cancel or adjust your stay.
- Flexibility depends on availability and timing, we'll do our best to accommodate requests.

6. Conduct & care

- Respect the hut, surroundings, and other visitors.
- On the hut terrace, no music or sounds other than normal conversation are allowed.
- Quiet hours from 22:00 to 07:00.
- No parties, loud music, or disruptive behaviour inside or outside the hut is allowed.
- Pets are welcome with prior agreement.
- Please take care of yourself and the space. Guests stay at their own responsibility.

7. Liability

- We trust guests to treat the bivouac with care. Any damage caused during your stay is your responsibility.
- Personal belongings are kept at your own risk.

8. Force majeure

- In case of extreme weather, natural hazards, or other unforeseeable situations, we may need to cancel or reschedule. We will communicate this as early as possible and discuss alternatives.

9. Privacy

- Your contact details are used only for booking and communication. They are not shared with third parties.
