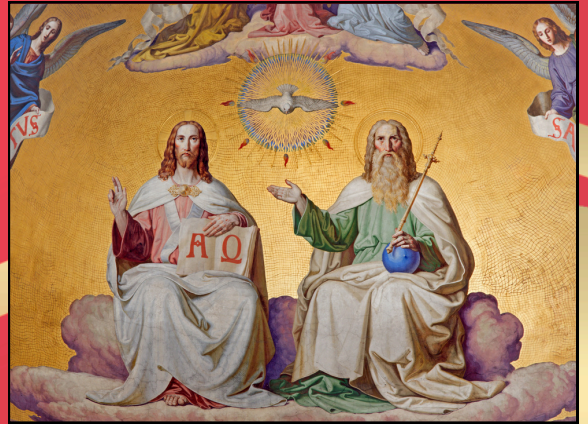

FATHER PEDRO WRITES:

THE BLESSED TRINITY: ETERNALLY SHARED LOVE

We can imagine the amazement of the disciples when Christ told them: *"I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak"* (John 12:49). From then onwards they must have listened to every word of Jesus in its relation to the Father. Saint Paul later understood this relation to be by means of the Spirit, as he wrote: *"no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God"* (1Cor 2:11). Putting these ideas together, we understand that Christ speaks of the Father, and that the Father speaks through Him by the Holy Spirit.

St. Thomas Aquinas describes the Holy Spirit as the tangible love between the Father and the Son, all Three being God eternally existent and self-sustaining. This Love, as is the case of all love, wills to be shared.

Christ reveals how the Father has shared everything with Him: *"All things have been given to Me by My Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him"* (Matthew 11:27). Keeping in mind St Paul's affirmation that the Spirit of God knows the thoughts of God (cfr. 1Cor 2:11), we gather that the Father shares everything with the Son by the Holy Spirit.

The Father is fully God, the Son is fully God, and the Holy Spirit is fully God, with not one being more so than the other, but all, individually in their Persons and taken as a whole, fully being God. The Love between them is so great that they have willed to share the fullness of Divinity with each other for ever.

God is eternally "Being" through the relationship between the Three Persons that are all One God. For Love must be shared to be, or it would simply not exist. Now God is Love eternally existent for *"He who does not love does not know God, for God is Love"* (1 John 4:8). All Three share deep affection with one another since all Eternity. This is clearly possible in the relational Triune God of Christianity with Father loving Son and Son loving Father perfectly and eternally through the Holy Spirit.

I would like to say thank you to Oliver Russell, a neophyte who was recently baptised at St Peter's Church - Easter Vigil Mass. Oliver kindly wrote an article on The Trinity, from which I have extracted inspiration for my thought for the week.

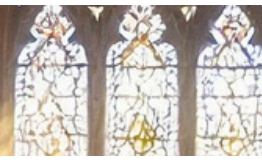

This July, our parish family will celebrate a very special milestone - one hundred years since the first Mass was offered in the present St Peter's Church building in 1926. Whilst the church building marks its centenary this year, the Catholic story in Winchester stretches back much further still. From the witness of the Winchester Martyrs to the historic chapel built by Bishop Milner in 1792, generations of faithful people have prayed, worshipped and served here through times of challenge and blessing alike.

Over the course of three celebrations in July, we invite parishioners past and present, friends of the parish and the wider community to come together in thanksgiving for all that God has done through St Peter's and The Winchester Martyrs Parish over the last century.
