

Wander Watcher Tag for Schools and Daycares.

Recess, class transitions, field trips, and high-sensory periods can increase wandering and elopement risks in some students with autism.

To help reduce the risk of an emergency, use a tag like this one. Assign a staff member or volunteer to be the designated one-to-one watcher during these times.
