BOYER IS COMMITTED TO MAINTAIN CHAIN OF CUSTODY CERTIFICATION TO DEMONSTRATE TO STAKEHOLDERS THAT WOOD PRODUCTS USED AT OUR MILL HAVE ORIGINATED FROM SUSTAINABLY MANAGED FORESTS.

We are committed to:

- Ⓐ Ensuring that the wood we use is produced from sustainably managed forests, managed in accordance with all State and National legislation.
- Ⓐ Implementing best efforts to avoid trading and sourcing wood or wood products from the following categories:
 - a) Illegally harvested wood;
 - b) Wood harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights;
 - c) Wood harvested in forests where high conservation values are threatened by management activities;
 - d) Wood harvested from forests being converted to plantations or non-forest use;
 - e) Wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted
- Ⓐ Providing assurance of the continuity, integrity and validity of the Chain of Custody system and the products certified by it in accordance with AS4707, FSC-STD-40-004 and FSC-STD-40-005.
- Ⓐ Conducting our activities in compliance with relevant environmental legislation, regulations and permit conditions.
- Ⓐ Recognising employee's rights consistent with State and National legislation and ILO Core Conventions.
- Ⓐ Conducting regular reviews, monitoring and auditing of our Chain of Custody system to ensure continuous improvement.
- Ⓐ Ensuring employees are aware of their responsibilities and providing appropriate training and support to ensure integrity of the system.
