Lauren

A year ago, Lauren's life changed when a sudden attack from multiple sclerosis left her numb from the waist down. Her quality of life severely declined after additional neurological attacks, leaving her searching for answers - and hope.

Lauren had the opportunity to receive a life-changing treatment called HSCT—a stem cell transplant combined with chemotherapy, designed specifically for multiple sclerosis patients. However, the treatment center that offered it is in San Diego, California, over 1,100 miles away from her home in Seattle. She didn't know how she was going to afford the airfare for this medically necessary flight.



Mercy Medical Angels helped relieve some of the financial stress and logistical burden she was carrying. Lauren found the straightforward, supportive, and clear process refreshing to be a part of. She felt cared for, like she was treated with her humanity in mind.

Today, Lauren is grateful for the support that made her treatment possible. "Thank you so much for creating and offering this service into the world," she shared. "It is needed, appreciated, and helping people in tangible and meaningful ways."

Mission in Motion

Troy

Troy was diagnosed with metastatic prostate cancer back in 2017. Now in 2025, he's been diagnosed with Multiple Myeloma.

Troy lives in Kentucky, where there aren't many good treatment options nearby. His doctors said his best bet would be at MD Anderson in Houston, Texas. Driving would be too expensive and take too long, but flying commercial would expose him to other diseases that could make his health worse.

That was when Troy learned about Angel Flight Mid-Atlantic volunteer pilots, a program of Mercy Medical Angels. He discovered they are truly special people who enjoy giving back to their communities. In his case, two of the volunteer pilots who flew him were doctors who combine their love of flying with taking care of people.

Troy received flights from Kentucky to Houston and back, and his experience exceeded his expectations. His pilots were amazing, the flight was great, and he is maintaining financial stability plus overall wellness—all thanks to Mercy Medical Angels and their volunteer pilot program. "I was blessed," Troy shared. "I'm forever grateful!"



Marcia



Marcia served in the U.S. Army with pride. But a few months ago, she started feeling off. Her mind wasn't as sharp and her mood was headed downhill. She also started having other mental and emotional struggles. Doctors diagnosed her with Post Traumatic Stress (PTS) and recommended she attend a healing retreat so she could get back to herself.

After a lot of research, Marcia came across a week-long women's retreat offered by the American Warrior Association and it seemed like a good fit. The retreat was free to apply and attend, but Marcia couldn't find a way to get from her home in North Carolina to where the retreat was being held in Colorado.

Angel Wings for Veterans, a program of Mercy Medical Angels, made it possible for Marcia to attend the healing retreat by providing commercial airline tickets. Because of this support, Marcia's quality of life has improved. Her physical and mental wellness are getting better as well.

Thanks to Mercy Medical Angels and Angel Wings for Veterans, Marcia re-discovered her fighting spirit and also found peace. "I can't thank you enough for your help," she shared

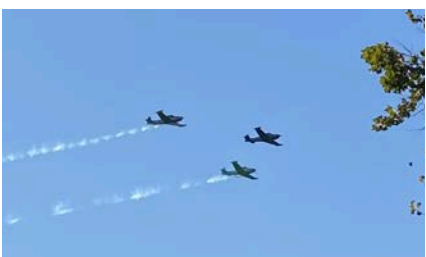

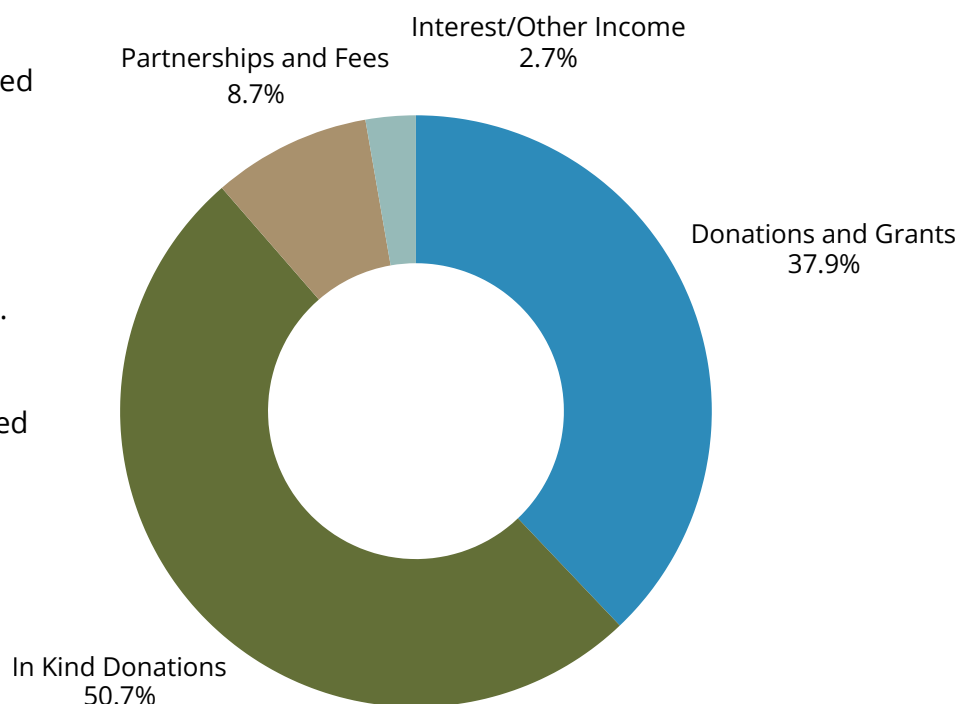

Golfers enjoyed a beautiful day on the green, a pre-event flyover, and camaraderie for a great cause.

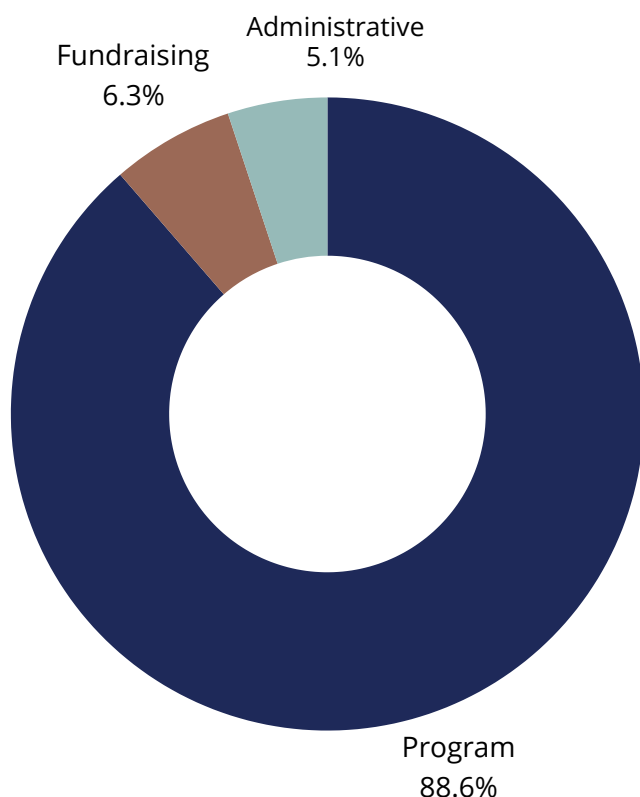


Financials
