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Robot Regents: Hochul Outsourced Our Kids' Education to an AI

Nassau County Executive and Republican nominee for Governor Bruce Blakeman today demanded an immediate, independent investigation into the New York State Board of Regents, slamming Governor Kathy Hochul for allowing unvetted artificial intelligence to generate this year's high-stakes high school graduation exams. The demand follows a groundswell of outrage from educators, parents, and panicked students who exposed the June Biology and Earth Science Regents exams as unreadable, structurally glitchy, and riddled with classic AI-hallucinated errors and nonsensical diagrams.

"Our kids spent the entire school year working hard, studying, and preparing for their futures—only to sit down for a high-stakes exam that looked like it was cooked up by a generic chatbot in five minutes," said Blakeman. "Kathy Hochul has completely abandoned her duty to oversee our state's education system. This is systemic incompetence, and it's a direct slap in the face to every teacher who pours their heart into the classroom and every parent expecting standard accountability from Albany."

Blakeman is formally calling on the State Inspector General to launch an immediate inquiry into the procurement and development process of the June 2026 test cycle to determine exactly how algorithmic content was approved for graduation-level testing without rigorous human oversight.

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
