

# Netradyne 2026 Top Driver Awards

## Overview

### What is the Netradyne Top Driver Awards program?

The Top Driver Awards is Netradyne's premier annual recognition program celebrating the highest ranked professional drivers across our customer network. Using real GreenZone® Score data, we identify and honor drivers who demonstrate exceptional safety, measurable improvement, and outstanding performance — and the organizations that support them.

### Why did Netradyne create this program?

At Netradyne we believe drivers deserve to be recognized. These awards are grounded in the same GreenZone data customers already rely on for coaching and operations — objective, transparent, and directly tied to real performance. This is recognition that means something.

### Who can participate and is there a cost?

The program is open to all current U.S.-based Netradyne customers. There is no cost to participate. Customers may nominate drivers across multiple categories.

## Eligibility & Nominations

### How do I nominate a driver?

Submit a nomination on your driver's behalf via the [nomination form](#) by Friday, June 26, 2026. No individual sign-up is required from the driver. Multiple nominations per organization are welcome — please submit a separate form for each driver. A single driver may only be nominated in one category.

### Is my organization eligible?

To be eligible, your organization must:

- Be a current, U.S.-based Netradyne customer active for at least 12 months (Rookie category: at least 6 months)
- Maintain at least 95% device deployment across your fleet
- Not be using a competing camera solution
- Have no history of fraudulent reporting or disqualifying events

Nominated drivers must meet minimum activity threshold required for valid GreenZone scoring, average at least 16 hours of driving per week during the evaluation period, and be actively employed by the nominating organization at the time of selection. Both company drivers and owner-operators are eligible.



### What do I need to include in my nomination?

Complete all sections of the nomination form, including driver information, safety signal responses, and a qualitative assessment covering the driver's performance, safety habits, and any coaching or improvement evidence. You'll also be asked to attach the driver's last 12 months of GreenZone performance data — this is a required part of the submission. The more specific and detailed your responses, the better the committee can evaluate your nominee.

In the event additional information is needed, we will reach out to you through the email address provided.

### What if a driver has a prior accident or violation on their record?

It does not disqualify them. Accident history, moving violations, and CSA inspection records are considered as a tiebreaker only when candidates are otherwise equally matched. A driver with a clean record will be considered the stronger candidate in that scenario.

### How will I know my nomination was received?

You'll receive a confirmation email upon submitting the nomination form. All nominators will also be notified of the outcome following winner selection on Friday, July 31, 2026.

## Award Categories

### What are the award categories and how many winners are selected?



#### Top Driver

Exceptional GreenZone scores, sustained safe-driving streaks, and minimal alerts. One winner will be selected from a set number of verticals.\*



#### Rising Star

Greatest measurable improvement — largest GreenZone score increase or reduction in risky events — comparing the first six months of the evaluation period to the second. Three overall winners across all verticals.\*



#### Rookie

At least six months of driving history with their current organization. Recognizes exceptional early progress relative to peer benchmarks. Three overall winners across all verticals.\*

## Evaluation & Scoring

### How are winners selected?

The Driver Awards Committee evaluates each nominee using two inputs: GreenZone performance data extracted from Netradyne systems — including score averages, safe-driving streaks, risky event counts, and improvement trends — and the nomination form, which includes accident history, CSA records, career mileage, and a narrative from the nominating party. GreenZone system data is the authoritative source of record for all performance metrics. Submitting a nomination does not guarantee evaluation if eligibility criteria are not met.

### What is the GreenZone® Score and what does it measure?

The GreenZone Score is the industry's first driver scoring algorithm, built on billions of miles of driving data, analyzing 100% of captured drive time. It accounts for risk indicators — speeding, sign violations, traffic light violations, hard braking, hard acceleration, following distance, distracted driving, forward collision warnings, weaving, and U-turns — as well as positive behaviors like safe following distance and sustained safe-driving streaks. Scores use alert rates, not raw counts, so drivers on longer routes or higher-risk roads are not unfairly penalized.

### What evaluation period is used?

A rolling 12-month period prior to the close of nominations (Rookie category: minimum 6 months). For Rising Star, the first six months are compared to the second to measure improvement.

## Recognition

### What do winners receive?

Here's what every winner can expect:

- An in-person recognition ceremony at their primary work location
- A trophy, personalized certificate, and branded jacket
- Public recognition across Netradyne's website, blog, social media, and press release
- Professionally produced video and photography captured onsite, showcasing the driver and their organization

### What does an onsite celebration look like?

Each winner's celebration is held at their primary work location and includes a catered lunch, trophy presentation, and custom winner jacket. Netradyne representatives will be on-site to present the award and capture professional video and photography. ### What evaluation period is used?

### What are the key dates?

- Entry Opens: Monday, May 4, 2026
- Entry Closes: Friday, June 26, 2026
- Winner Selection: Friday, July 31, 2026
- Winners Announced: Monday, August 3, 2026
- Onsite Celebrations & Filming: September & October 2026

### How will winners be notified?

Winners and their organizations will be notified following the Monday, August 3, 2026 announcement. Onsite celebration logistics and content capture will be coordinated directly with the winning organization at that time.
