

# Netradyne Driver Awards Program

## Rules and Terms & Conditions



Netradyne, Inc. ("Netradyne") is hosting the Netradyne Driver Awards Program ("Program") to recognize outstanding driver safety and performance across its customer network. By submitting a nomination, all participants and nominating parties agree to be bound by these Program rules (these "Rules"). Participation is at no cost to the driver or their organization (other than the eligibility requirement that the organization be an existing Netradyne customer). All Program decisions made by the Driver Awards Committee are final.

## Eligibility

### To be eligible, a nominated driver's organization must:

- Be a current, U.S.-based Netradyne customer in good standing and active for at least 12 months (Rookie category: at least 6 months);
- At least 95% device deployment across the fleet;
- Not be using a competing camera solution; and
- Have no history of fraudulent reporting or disqualifying events.

### Nominated drivers must:

- Be an employee of the nominating organization in the U.S. aged 18 years or older, and whose position at the organization principally involves driving a vehicle equipped with Netradyne's device and solution within the organization's fleet;
- Meet minimum activity thresholds (hours and miles) required for valid GreenZone scoring;
- Average at least 16 hours of driving per week during the evaluation period; and
- Be actively employed by the nominating organization at the time of selection.

Netradyne reserves the right to disqualify any organization or driver who fails to meet these criteria.

## Award Categories



### Top Driver

Exceptional GreenZone scores, sustained safe-driving streaks, and minimal alerts. One winner will be selected from a set number of verticals.\*



### Rising Star

Greatest measurable improvement — largest GreenZone score increase or reduction in risky events — comparing the first six months of the evaluation period to the second. Three overall winners across all verticals.\*



### Rookie

At least six months of driving history with their current organization. Recognizes exceptional early progress relative to peer benchmarks. Three overall winners across all verticals.\*

\*Trucking, Distribution, Home & Commercial Services, Infrastructure & Construction Services, Waste & Sanitation, and Passenger Transit.

## Evaluation Methodology

Winners are selected, in part, using Netradyne's GreenZone® Score — the industry's first driver scoring algorithm, built on billions of miles of driving data. The score analyzes 100% of captured driving time and reflects both positive behaviors and risk indicators, giving a complete and balanced picture of driver performance.

The score accounts for a wide range of driving behaviors, including speeding, sign violations, traffic light violations, hard braking, hard acceleration, following distance, distracted driving, forward collision warnings, weaving, and U-turns, as well as positive behaviors such as safe following distance and creating space for merging vehicles, and sustained safe-driving streaks across Stop Sign, Safe Speed, Attentive Driving, and Safe Following Distance.

Scores are based on alert rates — not raw counts — normalizing for drive time and route conditions, so drivers on longer routes or higher-risk roads are not unfairly penalized. Alert severity and duration are also factored in, and drivers generating alerts over very short drive times are given the benefit of the doubt.

## Nomination; How to Participate

Nominations must be submitted by customers via the official nomination form found [here](#) by June 26, 2026. One form per driver; multiple nominations per organization are welcome. Submission of a nomination does not guarantee evaluation if eligibility criteria are not met.

## Selection Process

The Driver Awards Committee evaluates each nominee to determine the safest driver within their category based on two inputs: GreenZone performance data extracted from Netradyne systems (including score averages, safe-driving streaks, risky event counts, and improvement trends) and nomination form submissions, which include the driver's accident history, CSA and inspection records, career mileage, and a narrative assessment from the nominating party. GreenZone system data is the authoritative source of record for all performance metrics and will prevail over any conflicting information submitted by the organization.

Safety signal responses — including accident history, moving violations, and CSA inspection records — do not disqualify a candidate but will be considered in evaluating the candidate against other candidates who are otherwise equally matched. A driver with a clean record across these signals will be considered the stronger candidate.

Committee members each independently review each candidate, then convene to discuss finalists, resolve ties, and confirm eligibility.

Final decisions are documented for transparency. All nominating organizations will be notified of the outcome, provided that any participating organization may receive a list of the winners by contacting the Netradyne representative indicated below during the 90 days following the winner announcements.

If a selected winner cannot be reached after reasonable attempts, or is found ineligible, Netradyne reserves the right to select an alternate winner.

## Recognition

### Each winner receives:

- In-person recognition ceremony at their primary work location;
- Trophy, personalized certificate, and branded jacket;
- Public recognition via Netradyne's website, press releases, and social media; and
- Feature in Netradyne customer success content, including testimonials, case studies, and video.

Awards are non-transferable. Netradyne is not responsible for delays in delivery due to supply issues or other unforeseen circumstances.

- Period for submissions closes at: Friday, June 26, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. PST
- Winner Selection: Friday, July 31, 2026
- Winners Announced: Monday, August 3, 2026
- Onsite Celebrations & Filming: September & October 2026
