What's included in VR Road Accident with Dangerous Goods



The assessment starts right after your vehicle has been hit by a following car.

You will stop the engine, take the sign, go out to place a sign, check the other driver's condition and his car, and check your vehicle's parts and the load.

After that you will communicate with your dispatcher, inform them about the accident, make photos of both cars and more.

The accident takes place in the morning on the road in a rural location.


Module Walkthrough

In the Learning Mode you'll be guided through the following steps. In the Training and Exam modes you'll be on your own completing the task. To exit the task press the Menu button.



1. Welcome to the Road accident with dangerous goods VR training. Select the mode. To do this, point the controller at the mode and pull the trigger.





2. Stop the engine. Turn the ignition key. To do this, move your hand to the subject and press the trigger of the controller.

3. Take out the ignition key. To pick up an item, move your hand to it and pull the controller trigger.

4. Use the parking brake. To do this, move your hand to the object and press the trigger. After that, the indication will light up on the dashboard.

5. Turn on the emergency lights. To do this, move your hand to the highlighted button. Then pull the trigger on the controller.

6. Take a reflective vest. To do this, move your hand to the highlighted area of the vest. Then pull the trigger on the controller.


7. Put on your vest. To do this, bring an object to the highlighted area on the body. Then press the trigger of the controller.

8. Put on dielectric gloves. To do this, move your hand to the gloves and press the trigger of the controller.

9. Take the emergency stop sign.

10. Make sure there is no passing traffic through the side mirror. To do this, point the controller at the mirror. Then pull the trigger on the controller. Then point at the correct option in the menu and pull the trigger.

11. Get out of the car. To do this, move your free hand to the highlighted area on the door. Then pull the trigger on the controller.



12. Go to the emergency stop sign installation area at a distance of thirty meters from the last car in the accident. To move, point the controller at the green circle and pull the trigger.

13. Install the emergency stop sign. To do this, put it in the installation area. Then press the trigger of the controller.

14. Come to the second participant in the incident.

15. Check if the other person involved in the incident needs medical attention. Point the controller and pull the trigger.

16. Check out your vehicle. Inspect the gas tank and the asphalt underneath for leaks. To test, move the controller pointer over one of the highlighted areas and pull the trigger, then repeat the steps to test the other highlighted area.

17. Inspect the engine of the other vehicle and the asphalt underneath for sparks and leaks. To test, move the controller pointer over one of the highlighted areas and pull the trigger, then repeat the steps to test the other highlighted area.

18. Check your trailer for leaks and damage.

19. Go to the cabin. To do this, go to the door. Move your hand to the highlighted area. Then pull the trigger on the controller.

20. Activate the GPS button and transfer the requested data to the operator. To do this, move your hand to the highlighted button. Then pull the trigger on the controller.

21. Take your phone from your belt and open the dialer. To do this, point the controller pointer at the corresponding button and pull the trigger.



22. Call the dispatcher and provide information about the accident. To do this, point the controller to the dispatcher's contact. Then pull the trigger on the controller. Then point over the call confirmation button. Then pull the trigger on the controller.
23. To exit to the phone's main menu, point the controller's pointer over the back button on the screen. Then pull the trigger on the controller.
24. Take photographs of the damage, as well as the circumstances of the incident
25. Go to the highlighted area in front of the cars. Then take a photo of the incident so that both cars are in the frame. To do this, bring the phone to the highlighted area so that both cars can be seen on the screen. To do this, point the controller pointer at the Take Photo button and pull the trigger.
26. Go to the second highlighted area in front and take the second photo of the incident.
27. Go to the highlighted area behind the cars. Then take a photo of the incident so that both cars are in the frame. To do this, point the controller pointer at the Take Photo button and pull the trigger.
28. Go to the next area behind the cars and take another photo of the incident.
29. To complete the training, go to the back of your trailer, point the controller pointer at the traffic police standby button. Then pull the trigger on the controller.
30. The task is completed.
31. To exit the task press the Menu button.
