Participants will apply their knowledge by supervising a real well drilling operation, gaining experience in:

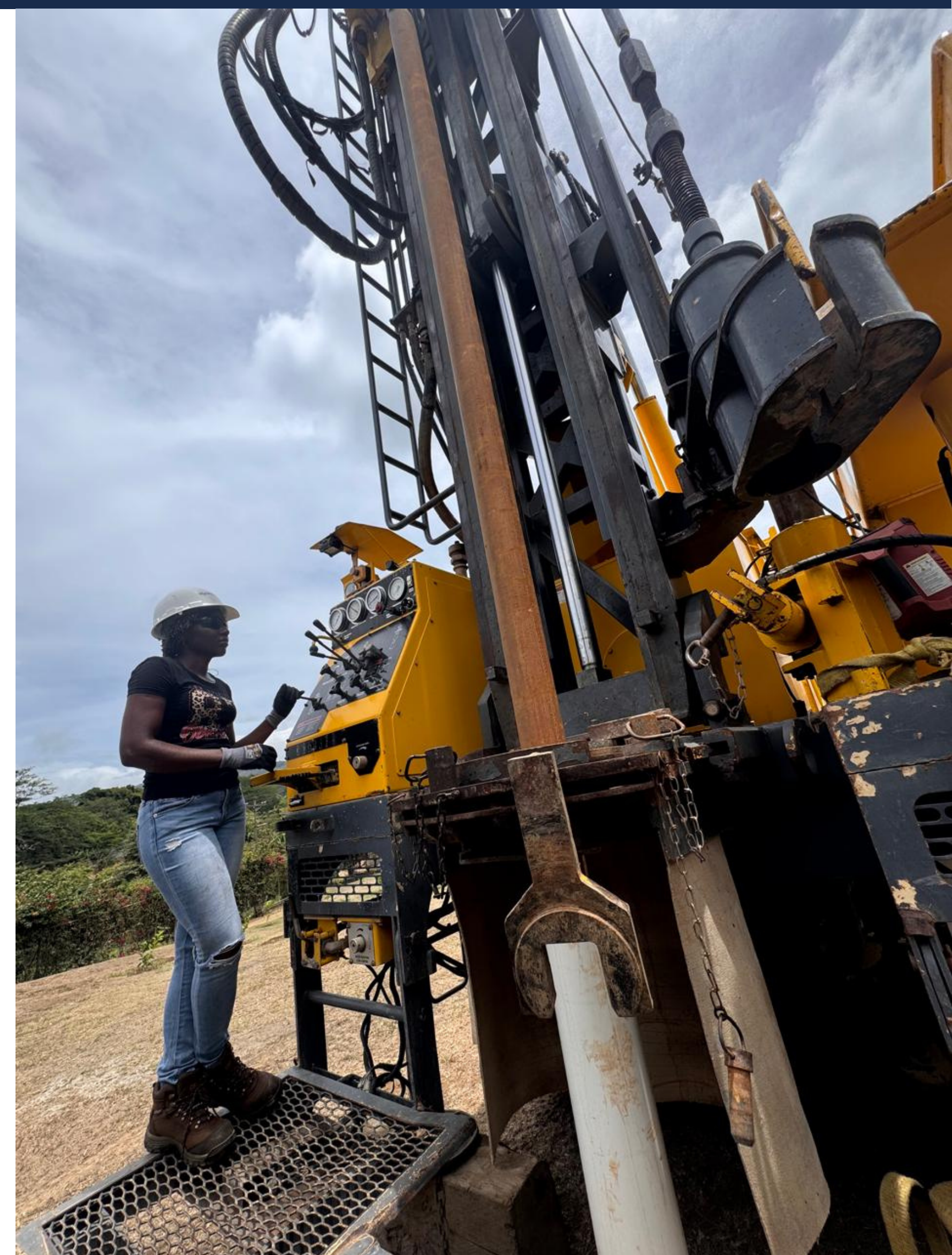
- On-site supervision
