

PRIVACY & SECURITY POLICY

Effective Date: January 1, 2026

This Privacy & Security Policy (the "Policy") explains how girlsonlytravel.com ("we", "us", or "our") collects, uses, stores, protects, and discloses personal data obtained through the Site, during travel bookings, in correspondence, during participation in our trips, or through any related interaction with us. By using the Site or providing us with your information, you acknowledge that you have reviewed this Policy.

1. Scope of the Policy

This Policy applies to personal data that we collect through the Site, email, booking forms, messaging applications, social media, participation in our trips, and other related communication channels.

This Policy does not apply to third-party websites, platforms, or services that operate under their own privacy practices, even where links to them are available on the Site.

2. Data Controller and Contact Details

For the purposes of this Policy, girlsonlytravel.com acts as the controller and organizer of the relevant personal data processing activities.

3. Categories of Data We May Collect

Depending on how you interact with us, we may collect your name, phone number, email address, messaging or social media handles, country of residence, and other contact details.

In connection with bookings or trip organization, we may process itinerary details, selected program information, travel dates, special requests, emergency contacts, payment status, amount paid, and transaction reference information. Where card payments are handled by third-party payment providers, we do not store full payment card details unless expressly stated otherwise.

We may also automatically collect technical data, such as IP address, browser type, device type, interface language, time zone, Site activity logs, cookies, and similar identifiers.

Please do not send us sensitive personal data unless it is objectively necessary. If you voluntarily provide health information, allergies, dietary restrictions, or other special-category information for trip organization purposes, you consent to our processing of that information to the extent necessary to provide the requested services.

4. Sources of Personal Data

We collect personal data directly from you when you submit a form on the Site, contact us by email or messaging applications, book a trip, send documents, or otherwise interact with us.

In certain cases, we may receive information from contractors, payment providers, partners, carriers, local hosts, or persons whom you have authorized to act on your behalf.

5. Purposes of Processing

We use personal data to receive and process inquiries, arrange and fulfill bookings, organize travel, provide support, send service messages, confirmations, invoices, and other operational communications.

We may also use data to operate and improve the Site, perform analytics, maintain internal records, comply with legal obligations, protect our rights and legitimate interests, and send marketing communications where we have an appropriate lawful basis.

6. Legal Bases for Processing

We process personal data on one or more of the following grounds: performance of a contract or steps taken at your request before entering into a contract; your consent; compliance with legal obligations; protection of our legitimate interests where such interests are not overridden by your rights and freedoms; and any other basis permitted by applicable law.

Where consent is required for a specific processing activity, you may withdraw it at any time. Such withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before the withdrawal took effect.

7. Cookies, Analytics, and Similar Technologies

We may use cookies, pixels, browser local storage, and similar technologies to enable essential Site functionality, remember settings, measure audience activity, analyze user behavior, and evaluate marketing effectiveness.

You may manage cookies through your browser settings or other available tools. Disabling certain cookies may impair the operation of some Site features.

8. Disclosure to Third Parties

We may share personal data with third parties to the extent necessary for the purposes described in this Policy, including hosting providers, IT contractors, payment services, analytics tools, carriers, hotels, insurers, local hosts, professional advisers, and other suppliers involved in trip organization or Site operations.

We may also disclose data when required by a court, law enforcement authority, or other competent authority, or where disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect our rights, user safety, investigate fraud, or comply with law.

9. Cross-Border Data Transfers

Because our services involve international travel, certain personal data may be transferred to suppliers or partners located outside Ukraine or outside your country of residence.

Where such transfers occur, we will take reasonable contractual and organizational steps to protect personal data to the extent practicable, taking into account the nature of the service, the travel itinerary, and applicable legal requirements.

10. Data Retention

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary for the purposes for which it was collected and for any additional period required to perform a contract, maintain accounting or tax records, handle claims, protect rights, or comply with law.

After the relevant retention period expires, data is deleted, anonymized, or archived where further retention is permitted or required by law.

11. Security Measures

We implement reasonable technical, physical, and organizational safeguards designed to prevent unauthorized access, loss, destruction, alteration, disclosure, or other unlawful use of personal data.

Such safeguards may include access restrictions, secure communication channels, role-based controls, backups, software updates, and cooperation with contractors who undertake to maintain an appropriate level of confidentiality.

However, no method of transmission over the Internet and no method of electronic storage is completely secure, and therefore we cannot guarantee absolute security.

12. Your Rights

Depending on applicable law, you may have the right to access your personal data, correct inaccuracies, request deletion, restrict processing, object to certain processing, withdraw consent, and receive a copy of your data in cases provided by law.

To exercise such rights, please contact us using the details stated in this Policy. We may request additional information to verify identity and process the request securely.

13. Children and Minors

The Site and our services are not intended for individuals under 18 years of age. We do not knowingly collect personal data from minors through the Site.

If you become aware that a minor has provided personal data to us without an adequate legal basis, please contact us so that we may take reasonable responsive measures.

14. Changes to this Policy

We may revise or update this Policy from time to time. The revised version will be posted on the Site together with its effective date.

Continued use of the Site after the effective date of any revision constitutes acknowledgment of the updated Policy and acceptance of its terms to the extent permitted by law.
