## Slide-by-Slide Template

### Slide 1: Title Slide

Purpose: Introduce your project and team

### Slide 2: What is Community Resilience?

Purpose: Define community resilience in your context

What to Include: Use a simple visual or phrase that explains preparedness, recovery, and equity.

### Slide 3: The Problem with the Grid

What to Include: Explain how this will improve public health, equity, jobs, resilience.

## **Slide 8: Process is Power**

Purpose: Emphasize collaboration and equity in the buildout

What to Include: Mention engagement, workforce development, and transparency.

## **Slide 9: Toolkit & Support Needed**

Purpose: What tools or support does your community need?

What to Include: List things like funding, technical assistance, partnerships.

## **Slide 10: Project Roadmap**

Purpose: High-level phases or steps

What to Include: Planning → Pilot → Construction → Programming → Scaling.

## **Slide 11: Call to Action**

Purpose: End with how people can help

What to Include: Invite funding, volunteering, partnerships. Include contact info.
