				✓	If any oil spills when refilling ensure spill is cleaned up straight away to avoid slips/falls	
Visibility	High			✓	Ensure windscreen wipers are in good working order and windscreen demister is operational	Driver
				✓	Ensure vision is good from vehicle before driving	
Cargo	Medium		✓		Ensure vehicle has a cargo barrier to physically separate driver and passengers from any cargo in vehicle	Driver
				✓	Any items placed in cargo area should be securely stowed to prevent movement and falling out of vehicle upon opening	
			✓		Ensure all tools, materials, boxes, stock etc is placed in rear of vehicle behind cargo barrier	
Fire	High			✓	Ensure vehicle has Fire Extinguisher easily accessible and is regularly tested/checked	Driver
Minor Injury	Low			✓	Ensure First Aid kit in vehicle with correct stocks	Driver & H&S Administrator
Vehicle Mechanical & Stability factors	High			✓	Ensure vehicle has current Warrant of Fitness	Driver and H&S Administrator
				✓	Ensure vehicle is regularly serviced with properly qualified motor vehicle repair agent	
				✓	Ensure vehicle tyres have good tread	
Driver	High			✓	Has current drivers licence	Driver and H&S Administrator
				✓	Get disclosure of drivers past driving history	
				✓	Wear seatbelt	
				✓	Only use cellphones on hands free basis	
				✓	Follow NZ driving laws at ALL TIMES
