

# Outdoor Learning



## ABC Scavenger Hunt

- Write A to Z on a piece of paper. Challenge your child to look outdoors and find something which begins with each letter!  
e.g. A = Apple, B=Berry, C=Conker

## Colour Scavenger Hunt

- Write some colours on a piece of paper. Challenge your child to look outdoors and find something of that colour!  
e.g. Green = Leaf, Brown = Stick

## Fill a bag...

- Simply give your child a carrier bag and see what they can collect!

## Build a bug hotel!

- Fill a cardboard tube with shredded paper, feathers, grass and pebbles. Keep checking every day to check which creepy crawlies have moved in!

## Flower Crowns

- Go for a walk and collect flowers, leaves and grasses along the way, which your child can then weave into a nature-inspired crown. They could make a classic daisy chain garland or knot grasses to create a wreath.

## Build a Den!

- Find some thick, long sticks and challenge your child to create their own shelter, either by leaning them up against a tree, or by lashing them together with string at the top for a tipi-style den.
- You could take an old sheet out with you to make den building more exciting!
