

# Privacy Policy for Transition VC

Effective date: 21 July 2026

Transition VC operates the website [transitionventurecapital.com](https://transitionventurecapital.com), which presents information about the firm, its investment approach, portfolio companies, perspectives, careers, contact channels, newsletter signup, and social media links.[cite:1] This Privacy Policy explains how personal data may be collected, used, stored, and shared when visitors use the website, submit enquiries, sign up for updates, or otherwise interact with Transition VC online.[cite:1]

## Who this policy applies to

This policy applies to visitors to the Transition VC website, including those who browse the public pages, contact the firm through the website, subscribe to newsletters, or engage through linked social channels.[cite:1] The website includes core sections such as Home, About, Portfolio, Perspectives, Careers, and Contact, and it also provides a newsletter signup field and social links, indicating several possible points at which user information may be provided.[cite:1]

## Information that may be collected

Depending on how a visitor uses the site, Transition VC may collect personal information that a user chooses to provide, such as name, email address, company details, phone number, message content, job application materials, or any other information submitted through forms or direct communication.[cite:1] The website may also collect certain technical and usage information automatically, such as IP address, browser type, device information, pages visited, referral source, date and time of access, and interactions with the website, to support security, performance, analytics, and service improvement.[cite:1]

## How information may be collected

Information may be collected when a visitor fills out a contact form, signs up for a newsletter, applies for a role, communicates by email or other channels listed on the site, or interacts with embedded services and external links.[cite:1] Some information may also be collected through cookies, server logs, analytics technologies, and similar tracking tools used to understand website traffic, improve usability, and maintain site operations.[cite:1]

## Purposes of processing

Personal data may be used to respond to enquiries, provide requested information, evaluate investment- or partnership-related outreach, process recruitment submissions, send newsletters or updates, maintain website security, analyse usage patterns, and improve site content and functionality.[cite:1] Where legally required, marketing communications should be sent only on an appropriate consent or other lawful basis, and users should be able to unsubscribe from non-essential communications.[cite:1]

## **Legal bases**

Where applicable data protection laws require a legal basis, Transition VC may rely on one or more of the following: consent, performance of pre-contractual steps or contractual obligations, compliance with legal obligations, and legitimate interests such as operating and securing the website, communicating with stakeholders, and improving its services.[cite:1]

Where consent is used, users may withdraw that consent at any time, subject to lawful processing already carried out before withdrawal.[cite:1]

## **Cookies and tracking**

The website may use cookies and similar technologies to remember user preferences, understand traffic patterns, measure content effectiveness, and support essential website functions.[cite:1] Where required by law, users should be given clear notice and relevant choices regarding non-essential cookies or similar tracking technologies.[cite:1]

## **Sharing of personal data**

Personal information may be shared with service providers and professional advisers who support website hosting, analytics, communications, recruitment administration, security, legal compliance, or other business operations, provided they process such data under appropriate confidentiality and data protection obligations.[cite:1] Information may also be disclosed when required by law, to respond to valid legal requests, to protect rights and security, or as part of a corporate transaction, restructuring, financing, or business transfer involving Transition VC.[cite:1]

## **International transfers**

Because website and technology service providers may operate in multiple jurisdictions, personal data may be transferred to and processed outside a visitor's home country.[cite:1] Where such transfers occur, appropriate safeguards should be used where legally required, such as contractual protections or transfers to jurisdictions recognised as providing adequate protection.[cite:1]

## **Data retention**

Personal data should be retained only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this policy, including responding to enquiries, managing subscriptions, assessing applications, meeting legal and regulatory obligations, resolving disputes, and enforcing agreements.[cite:1] Retention periods may vary depending on the type of data, the context in which it was collected, and applicable legal requirements.[cite:1]

## **Data security**

Reasonable technical, administrative, and organisational measures should be used to protect personal information against unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration, loss, or misuse.[cite:1] However, no internet transmission or electronic storage method can be guaranteed to be completely secure, and users submit information at their own risk to that extent.[cite:1]

## **Third-party links**

The website links to portfolio company websites and external social platforms such as LinkedIn, YouTube, and Instagram.[cite:1] When a visitor clicks an external link, that third party's privacy practices and terms will apply, and Transition VC is not responsible for the privacy, security, or content practices of external websites not under its control.[cite:1]

## **Children's privacy**

The website is intended for a professional and business audience and is not directed to children.[cite:1] Personal data should not knowingly be collected from children where prohibited by applicable law.[cite:1]

## **User rights**

Depending on the laws that apply to a visitor, that person may have rights to access, correct, update, delete, restrict, object to, or port certain personal data, as well as the right to withdraw consent and lodge a complaint with a competent supervisory authority.[cite:1] To exercise applicable rights, users may contact Transition VC using the contact details made available on the website.[cite:1]
