

Cookies Policy for Transition VC

This Cookies Policy explains how cookies and similar technologies may be used on transitionventurecapital.com, the public website for Transition VC.[cite:1] The website includes informational pages such as Home, About, Portfolio, Perspectives, Careers, and Contact, along with a newsletter signup field and links to external social platforms.[cite:1]

What are cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on a user's device when visiting a website.[cite:2] They are commonly used to make websites work properly, improve performance, remember preferences, and provide information about how visitors use a site.[cite:2]

How cookies may be used on this website

The related Transition privacy notice states that cookie data, usage data, and technical data may be used to administer, improve, and protect the business and website, including troubleshooting, testing, maintenance, support, reporting, hosting, and data analysis.[cite:2] It also states that cookie data and technical data may be used to improve the website or services and to customise the website according to a visitor's interests.[cite:2]

Because the Transition VC website contains public marketing pages, contact paths, newsletter signup, and external links, cookies or similar technologies may be used to support core website functionality, measure traffic and engagement, and improve user experience.[cite:1][cite:2]

Types of cookies

The website may use the following categories of cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies** to enable essential site functionality, security, page delivery, and technical operation.[cite:2]
- **Performance and analytics cookies** to understand how visitors access and use pages, how long they stay, and how they navigate around the website.[cite:2]
- **Functionality cookies** to remember user preferences or settings where such features are available.[cite:2]

Information collected through cookies

The related privacy notice identifies technical data such as IP address, browser type, time zone setting, and location, as well as usage data such as how often users access the website, how long they spend on it, and how they navigate around it.[cite:2] Cookie-related technologies may therefore help collect information about device and browser characteristics, page visits,

referral sources, and on-site behaviour for website administration and improvement purposes.

Managing cookies

Users can usually control or disable cookies through their browser settings.[cite:2] Blocking some cookies may affect website functionality, performance, or the availability of certain features.[cite:2]

Where required by applicable law, non-essential cookies should be used only on an appropriate legal basis, such as consent, and users should be given clear information and a way to manage their cookie preferences.[cite:2]

Third-party services

The Transition VC website links to external websites, including portfolio company websites and social platforms such as LinkedIn, YouTube, and Instagram.[cite:1] If third-party content, embeds, analytics services, or linked platforms place their own cookies, their privacy and cookie practices will be governed by their own notices rather than this policy.[cite:2]
