Preview Week: The Legacy of a Dangerous Gentleman

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 3:14 "If what has been built survives, the builder will receive a reward."

Reading: Legacy isn't left when you die, it's built while you live. You are building something now, with every word, hour, and habit. The question is, will it last? Dangerous gentlemen live like their choices echo into eternity. They don't live for applause today, but for fruit that outlives them. Your kids, friends, and heaven are watching. Build like it matters, because it does. Legacy is intentional, what you leave in the hearts of others. You're not just building a resume, you're building a ripple. How you live now will echo beyond you. Build wisely, build holy, build like the next generation depends on it, because it does. Legacy also means investing in people, not just projects. The world chases monuments: careers, wealth, fame, but God values the lives you shape. Your legacy is in the child who sees your faith, the friend who finds Christ through your example, or the stranger you serve without reward.
