The aim of this report is to strengthen our commitment to sustainability by using data to improve transparency and proactively manage environmental impact as our team continues to grow.

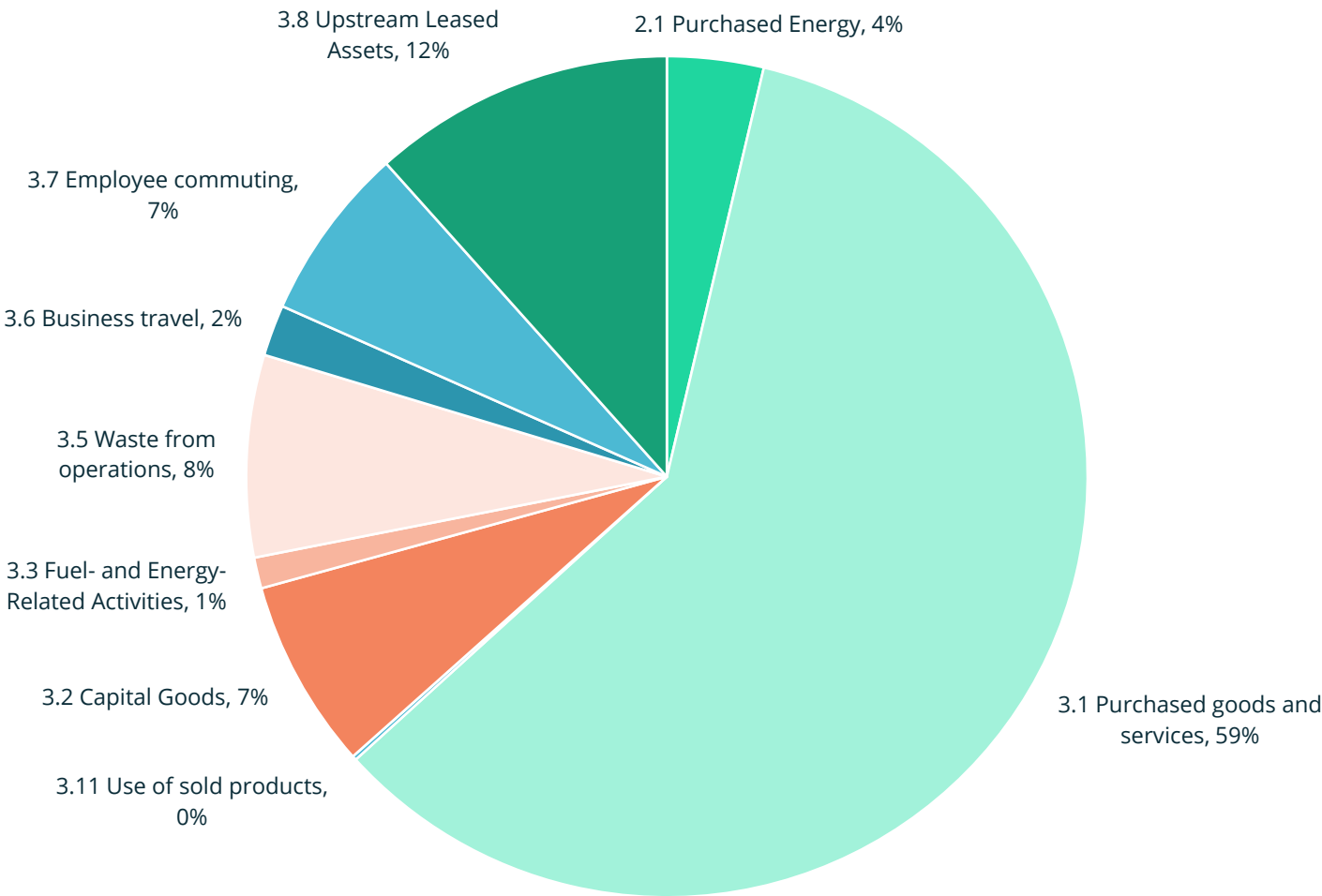

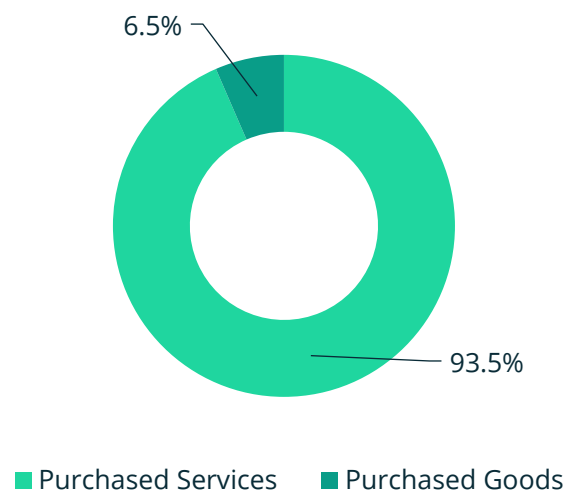

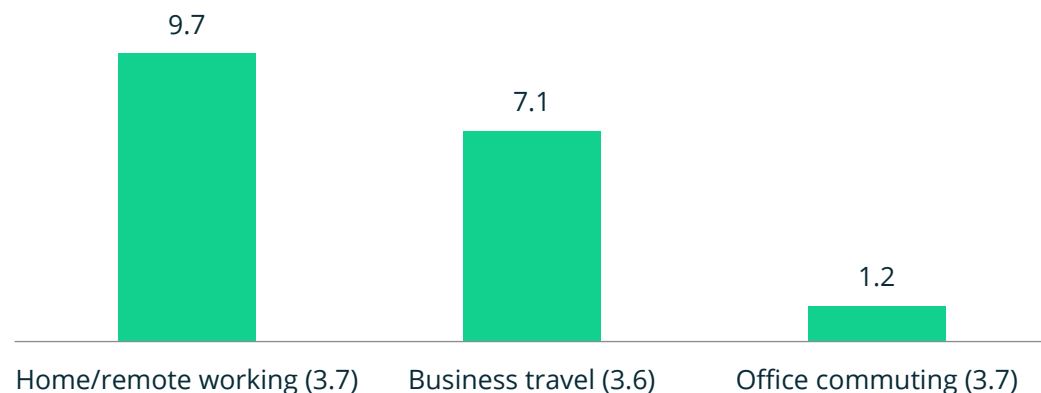

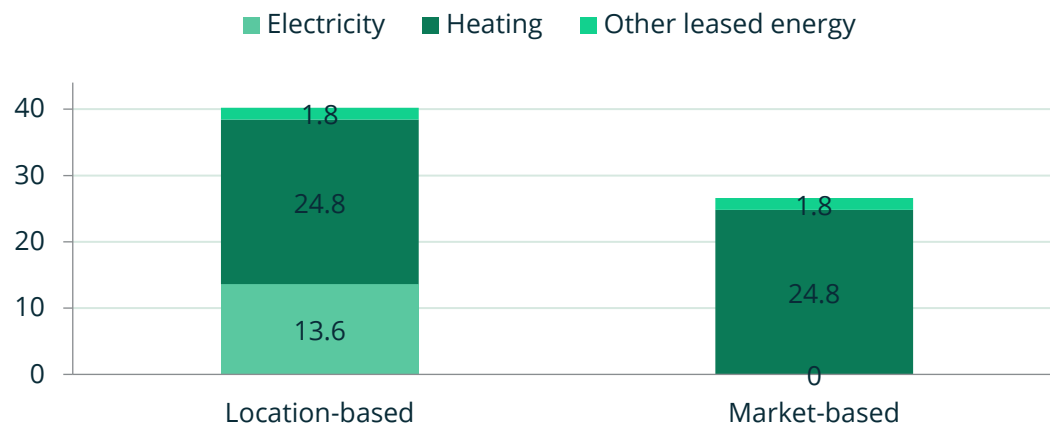
