



# Project Overview

**The Village of Shorewood is scheduled to reconstruct Oakland Avenue between Capitol Drive and Glendale Avenue. The project is scheduled to begin in February and be completed in December 2026.**

## Roadway

- Remove and reconstruct the roadway
- Construct curb extensions (bump-outs) and Rectangular Rapid Flash Beacons (RRFBs) throughout the project limits to enhance pedestrian safety
- Replace and modify the existing RRFBs at Jarvis Street
- Upgrade all traffic signals and street lighting

## Utilities

- Replace water mains and services, including the removal of lead pipes
- Install new fire hydrants and additional water valves
- Replace storm sewers and catch basins, and adjust manholes along the corridor

## Construction Impacts

- Traffic patterns, parking and pedestrian access will be impacted by this work
- Crews are scheduled to saw-cut expansion joints in the evening and overnight hours during paving operations. Noise is associated with this work
- Short-term water shut-offs are necessary while crews replace water mains and service lines. Some nighttime work is scheduled to accommodate businesses with daytime water needs

**Businesses and residents should be aware that noise and dust will be associated with this work. Steps are taken to minimize these effects.**

**Businesses along Oakland Avenue will remain OPEN FOR BUSINESS.**
