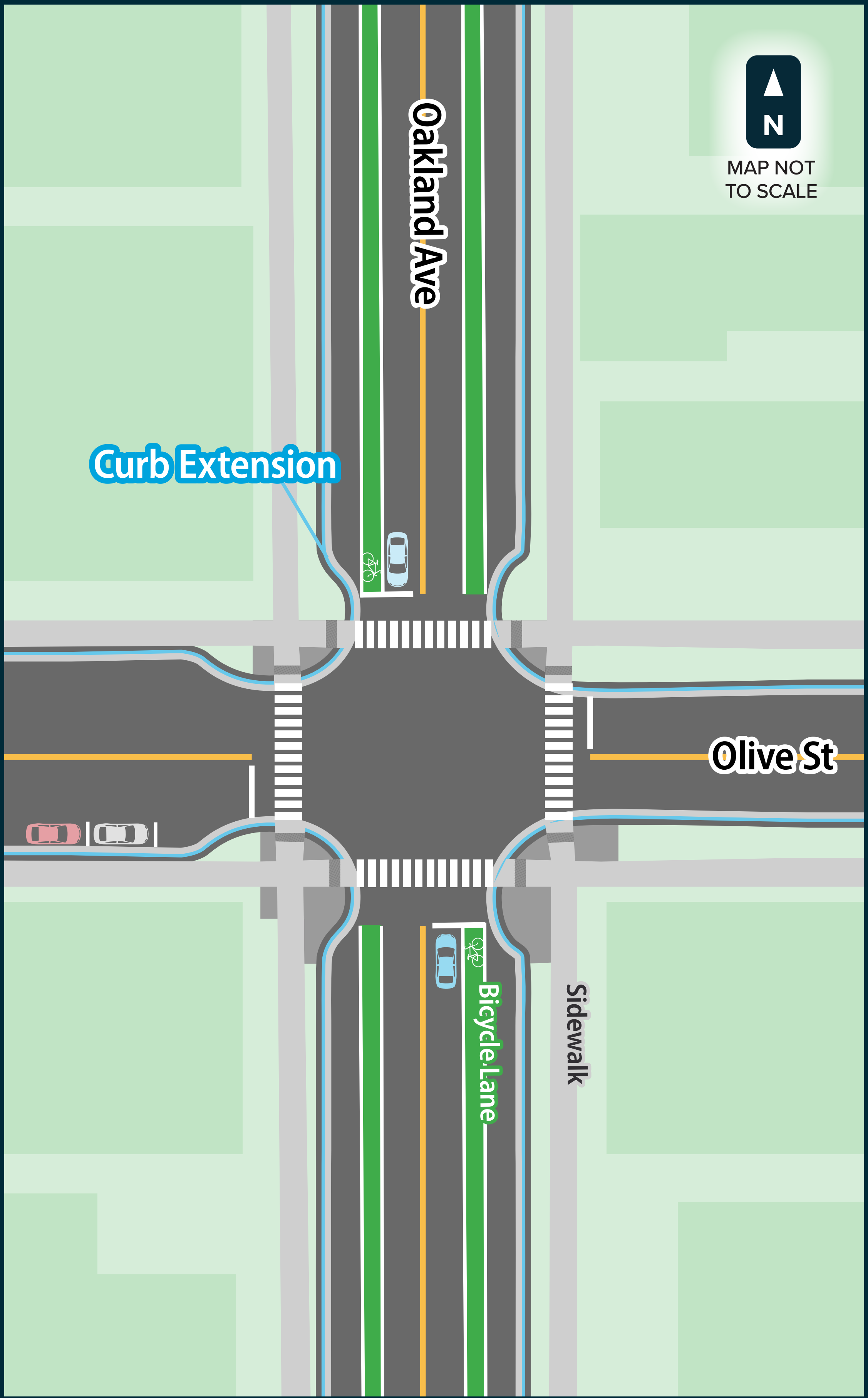




Curb Extensions



Curb Extensions

Curb extensions, also called curb bump-outs, are sidewalk areas that extend into the street at intersections or crossings. They help reduce the distance pedestrians must cross and the time they spend in the roadway. They can also slow vehicles down at intersections.

Beyond safety, curb extensions help calm traffic and create more comfortable, inviting streets for neighborhood activity and local businesses. On Oakland Avenue, curb extensions will be installed at all intersections and at the pedestrian crossing between Lake Bluff and Kensington boulevards.

- Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) will be installed at the curb extensions at Elmdale Court, Jarvis Street and Glendale Avenue.
