

Construction Forecast

The Village of Shorewood is reconstructing Oakland Avenue between Capitol Drive and Glendale Avenue. The following work is scheduled as part of this project.

Monday, August 17 through Thursday, August 20, 2026:

Crews are scheduled to mill and pave side-street connections east of Oakland Avenue between Elmdale Court and Kensington Boulevard.

- Elmdale Court at Oakland Avenue is scheduled to have short-term closures during these operations
- Milling and paving operations will limit parking on streets east of Oakland Avenue

Crews are scheduled to apply pavement markings to the new northbound lanes.

Looking Ahead:

- Surveying for storm sewer replacement and daytime pavement sawing on the west side of Oakland Avenue
- Storm sewer replacement

Note: Concrete in some areas of the northbound lanes is still curing. To prevent damage or delays, there is no parking in the work area, including newly paved sections. Vehicles parked in the work area are subject to towing.

Overnight and Weekend Work:

No overnight or weekend work is scheduled.



All work is weather dependent and subject to change.

Friday, August 21, 2026, by 5 p.m.:

Traffic is scheduled to be shifted to the east side of Oakland Avenue.

- Bidirectional traffic will resume on the east side of Oakland Avenue
- All streets and driveways on the east side of Oakland Avenue are scheduled to reopen
- Motorists will be able to cross Oakland Avenue at Kenmore Place, Lake Bluff Boulevard, and Glendale Avenue
- Elmdale Court west of Oakland Avenue will remain open
- Wood Place, Olive Street, Marion Street, and Kensington Boulevard west of Oakland Avenue are scheduled to close until mid-fall for roadway reconstruction
- Access to driveways on the west side of Oakland Avenue will be maintained



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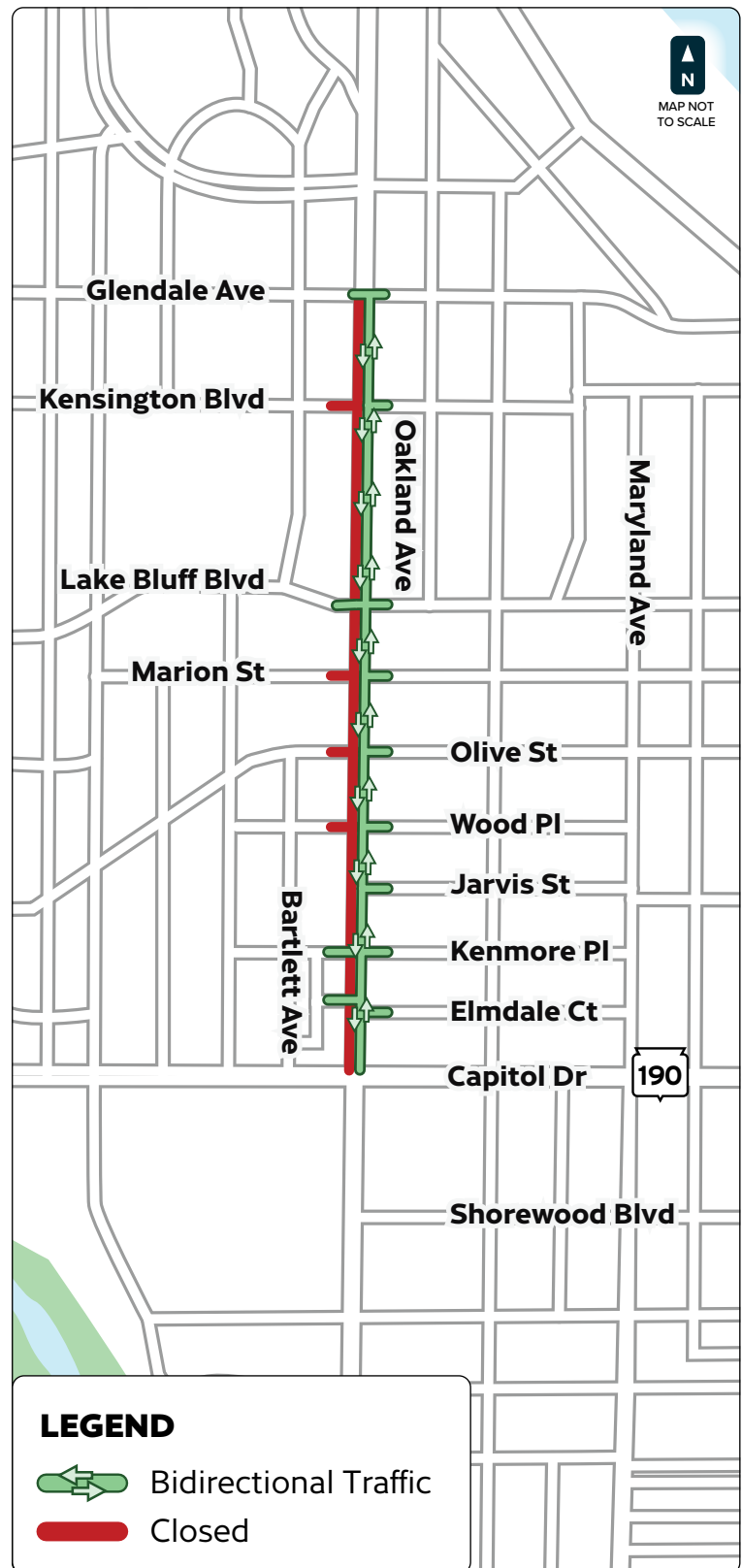
