SOHO HOTEL, LONDON

Set in a discreet mews off Dean Street, the Soho Hotel is a fun place to check in to during Fashion Week.

Every room here is unique – a signature move by the interior designer Kit Kemp – but comfort and style are guaranteed throughout. After a whirlwind of shows, head to the Refuel restaurant for a punchy Old Fashioned, before feasting on replenishing dishes of mushroom pappardelle and Cornish halibut. BROOKE THIES

SHOW STOPPERS

Find repose from fashion season's frenetic pace and recharge at a stylish urban sanctuary in the centre of the action

PORTRAIT MILANO, MILAN

Located in the Quadrilatero della Moda (the fashion district), Portrait Milano is the luxurious incarnation of a former archbishop's seminary, now owned by the Ferragamo family. At its centre is an impressive piazza, and off the hotel's 17th-century colonnades are 73 opulent suites decorated in rich reds and golds, with wood panelling, rattan accents and Carrara-marble finishes. The restaurants are superb: try the 'white pasta' at Bar Giardino, creamy with

a Parmesan sauce cooked for 24 hours. HELENA LEE

EXPERIMENTAL MARAIS, PARIS

A stay in one of this bijou Marais hotel's 43 rooms and suites feels akin to living in an exclusive private residence. In the evenings, dine on Manhattan fare with French flair (such as beef fillet tartare or lobster rolls in brioche) beneath a soaring vaulted ceiling at the Temple & Chapon restaurant. Afterwards, proceed to the American bar, where night owls sit sipping smoky negronis crafted with the alchemy that originally gave the Experimental Group its renown.
