### **What are cookies?**

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used by website owners in order to make their websites work, or to work more efficiently, as well as to provide reporting information.

Cookies set by the website owner (in this case, Invimatic) are called "first-party cookies." Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called "third-party cookies." The parties that set these third-party cookies can recognize your computer both when it visits the website in question and also when it visits certain other websites.

### **Why do we use cookies?**

We use first- and third-party cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons in order for our Website to operate, and we refer to these as "essential" or "strictly necessary" cookies. Third parties serve cookies through our Website for advertising, analytics, and other purposes. This is described in more detail below.

We may use cookies to enhance user experience or for delivery of our services. Our web servers automatically collect limited information about your computer connection to the Internet, including your IP address, when you visit our website. We use below types of cookies to provide our users personalized services and improved experience on our website.

Essential cookies- These are cookies that are required for the smooth operation of our website. These include cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use shopping cart and e-billing services.

Analytical cookies- These cookies allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors on our website and to see how they navigated through various areas of our website. These cookies are used by us to improve the user experience on our website, and to ensure that they can easily find what they are looking for at our website at a particular moment.

Functional cookies- These cookies are used by us to recognize you when you return to our website. This enables us, subject to your choices and preferences, to personalize our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences, such as your choice of language and region, and the product advertising you might be interested in. We may also share your information for legitimate use by third parties to help you access their services and serve you better.
