


Happy New Year!

Although we may not experience much of the winter white snow, we do experience colder temperatures, which seem to get colder and colder here each year. With this, the turfs are all susceptible to winter kill. Winter kill can be reduced by adding two applications of Diamond Grow to your turf. We would apply it along with lawn app #1 in January and then another application in March. We won't be able to tell whether areas of the turf need to be replaced or not until it fully comes out of dormancy, which is approximately mid-May.
