Why does my grass look like this?

It is totally normal for your grass to look like this at this time of the year. The grass is still in dormancy and will be until most likely mid May. There are different factors such as turf type and soil temperature, that determine when the turf comes out of dormancy, every yard is different. Do not be alarmed if your neighbor's yard greens up before yours. Zoysia is one turf type that takes longer to come out of dormancy than others.

If you suspect you have winterkill, we do need to wait until the turf is fully out of dormancy to determine whether it needs to be replaced or not. **Patience is key!**
