Mowing

The wait is over; our mowing season is in full swing. With that said, let's review some friendly reminders. Please make sure to have your yards cleaned up from your furry little friends. We cannot do lawn maintenance with feces in the yard and will skip the service.

Our mowing service includes mowing, edging, weed eating, blowing and spraying the beds with herbicide. We do not hand pull weeds.

For weekly mowing customers, we rotate weeks for edging. One week is a soft edge (beds, natural areas, asphalt roads) then opposite weeks will be a hard edge (driveways, walkways, sidewalks, road edges). We do this schedule to ensure the edging is not becoming too drastic.



Brown Patch

With the weather warming up, we are seeing a lot of brown patch in lawns across the Grand Strand and surrounding areas. Brown patch spreads fast. It first starts as circular areas of brown and dead grass surrounded by a narrow, dark ring. It thrives on moisture, so if you have brown patch, a fungicide treatment is necessary along with a reduction in watering. If you had a fungus in the fall, please know that that particular area may take longer to green up this year. An extra fungicide would not hurt to help strengthen the turf up and as a preventative.

Reminders

Mowing customers have a "typical" mow day, however that is not guaranteed and can change.

Irrigation

We are still working on our irrigation spring start ups.

If you do not have an irrigation package with us and are wondering what you should set your irrigation schedule to, we recommend the following at this time...

Sunny areas: 2-3x per week

Heavily Shaded areas: 1-2x per week.

Spray zones= 2-5 minutes each

Rotors= 20-30 minutes each
