

## Armyworms

Now is the time that fall armyworms start making their annual appearance. They start out as moths, laying a cluster of eggs on leaves, siding, electrical boxes, even car doors. A female moth can lay up to 2,000 eggs! It only takes 5-10 days for these eggs to hatch into tiny caterpillars. This larval stage is where they are most damaging as they begin feeding on your turf. They prefer to feed at night and can destroy your beautiful lawn very quickly.

## Lawn Apps

For customers with the standard 8 app fertilization and weed control package, we are currently finishing up lawn app #6. This was a complete balanced fertilizer. We will start lawn app #7 shortly. Lawn app #7 will be a liquid potassium fertilizer and winter pre-emergent for weeds

Premium Monthly lawn app customers, your September application will be diamond grow and an insecticide (armyworm preventative).



## Winter Services

If you have lawn apps with us, we highly recommend that you also have winter services with us. On winter services, the crews will make sure the leaves are out of the yard, so the applications get down into the grass and soil.
