## Poa Annua

Poa Annua is an invasive winter weed that you should be on the lookout for. If you have animals, you may see it pop up in areas where they urinate. The animal's urine may disturb our pre-emergent and allow this weed to grow in those areas. If you see this, don't be alarmed, it will die off once the weather warms up.

If you have areas that are bare from your furry friends and would like it filled in for the winter so you do not end up with a muddy mess, we can always lay down rye seed for you. Rye seed is a fast growing, cool-season grass and will germinate throughout the colder months.



## Cold Weather Kills

With cold weather around the corner, plants become susceptible to winter kill. To decrease the chances of death and increase survival, we highly recommend insulating the beds with mulch, pine straw or rock. Palms especially are more susceptible to this, since they are not used to colder conditions.
