



Keep those palms warm

It is especially important to insulate palm trees prior to the winter. Palms are used to hot, tropical weather, not cold harsh conditions. With our winters here becoming colder, we highly recommend insulating the palms to help increase their chance of survival throughout the winter. Mulch is an inexpensive and easy way to insulate them and help them to survive.

Winter Weeds

Make sure you have a pre-emergent laid down to prevent winter weeds from popping up. This is included on both of our 8 app and premium monthly lawn app programs. If you do not have one of our lawn app programs, sign up today. You can also call to have us do a one-time application for you.



BROWN PATCH

With the nights getting cooler, be on the lookout for brown patch. Watch out for circular areas of brown and dead grass surrounded by a narrow, dark ring. In the early morning, the outer ring will be a bright orange color. You can get a preventative fungicide which also helps to reduce the severity of winter kill.



IRRIGATION SHUTDOWN

We will be starting irrigation shutdowns shortly. If you do not have irrigation services with us, you can shut your system off to prevent possible damage. Reminder that we DO NOT blow out the lines here.



WINTER SERVICES

Today commences our mowing season. Winter services will begin next week. If you do not have winter services with us or if you are not sure if you do, contact us today to sign up or confirm. All of our services automatically renew with the same services you currently have.
