**BROWN
PATCH**

Brown patch is a fungus that mainly appears on the lawn during spring and fall. Once started, this disease can spread fast. Brown patch first appears as circular areas of brown and dead grass surrounded by a dark, narrow ring.

If you notice your lawn has brown rings, call now for a fungicide to help reduce the stress of spring brown patch.

In the early morning, the outer ring will be a bright orange color, which indicates the disease is active. Once the area is treated, it will slowly recover. If brown patch was treated in the late fall, it will be slower to green up in the spring.

WINTER KILL

Winterkill is used to describe the death of turfgrasses during winter months. There are numerous factors that can contribute to winterkill. Some of these factors include direct low temperatures, crown hydration, untreated diseases from the fall, and snow- and ice-covered turfs. We do not know for certain if those affected areas will come back or not until after the turf comes out of dormancy. This usually happens by mid-May. We can evaluate at that point and decide whether you need to replace those areas. We highly recommend a fungicide in the fall to prevent the severity of winter kill.

Premium Monthly Lawn App Program

January-
Pre-emergent weed control with liquid potassium fertilizer

February-
Top Choice- insecticide for mole crickets

March-
Diamond grow and fungicide

April-
Granular fertilizer

May-
Broadleaf weed control, liquid iron, Diamond grow and growth stimulator

June-
Granular fertilizer and spot treat weeds

July-
Diamond grow, growth regulator, spot treat weeds and insecticide (chinch bug and grub control)

August-
Liquid iron, liquid potassium and broadleaf weed control

September-
Diamond grow, insecticide (army worm preventative)

October-
Liquid potassium, winter pre-emergent, fungicide

November-
Diamond grow, spot treat fungus

December-
Winter pre-emergent, spot treat weeds

FRIENDLY REMINDERS to ensure your services this season go smooth:

- Our mowing season begins in April. If you are a bi-weekly mow, you may not get your first service until the 2nd week in April. Your typical mow day is not guaranteed, neither is a specific crew. Your mow day is weather and staff permitting. We try to keep your schedule and crew as close to consistent as we possibly can.
- The first few weeks of the season will take our crews longer, as they have to spend extra time on properties that have not been maintained since the fall. Reminder that if you have not had winter services with us or a clean-up, your first mowing will be charged at an hourly rate in order for us to get the property ready to perform regular maintenance for the 2026 season. *If it takes longer for the crew to maintain the first service, you will be charged an hourly rate on your first service.
- All reoccurring services automatically renew. In order to stop them, you must notify the office. Also, if you have any requests or concerns, please contact the office 843-652-5296 or by email at info@amazingbladeslandscaping.com.
- Please make sure all dog feces are cleaned up so our crews can maintain your yard. We are unable to maintain the yard if it's filled with feces. If we cannot service that portion of the yard, it will be skipped. As a common courtesy, we do not want our crews having to step in that or have our expensive mowers clogged. If we are unable to maintain the backyard on account of this issue, we still perform the rest of the service, and you are still charged for the service in its entirety.
- If you have new bulbs, annuals or anything that you do not want sprayed that could be mistaken for a weed, please flag them off so the crews do not mistake them for weeds.
- We do NOT bag clippings during mowing.
- Our waitlist during peak season can extend up to 9-12 weeks out. Right now, we are currently 4-8 weeks out on sod.
- Edging on weekly mowings is rotated. One week is a soft edge, the opposite week is a hard edge. This is done so the beds are not over edged and expanded into the grass.
- Please take a minute to read our newsletters. You will find a lot of valuable and useful information in them. During our busy season, telephone wait times also may be longer. A lot of concerns for telephone calls can all be found in our newsletters . We do this to help you save that telephone call and not have to deal with hold times.

dormancy until about mid-May. Zoysia owners,
do you remember when your turf was greener
than your neighbors in the fall? In the spring,
you have the opposite. Zoysia turf takes longer
to transition out of dormancy and green up. Do
not be alarmed if you have Zoysia and do not see
it fully greening up like your neighbors with
different turf.**
