## HAVE NO FEAR, SHRUB TRIMMING IS NEAR

We have officially started shrub trimming. We do not schedule this service. If you have the shrub trim package with us, we automatically come out and trim for you. All clients with the package will be done before clients who are requesting a one time trim without a package.

Make sure your shrubs are not forgotten about. If you do not have the shrub trim package with us, call today to get added to the list.

We perform a standard trim unless you notify the office with specific requests.

Also, please note that palm trees are trimmed on shrub trim #2 during the mid summer.



### Turf Replacement

Now is a great time to replace your unsightly turf. The last 2 winters we've had have been really harsh on our turf. If you need to replace sod due to winter kill or if you've been thinking about upgrading to a tougher turf, call us today to meet with a manager and discuss options and pricing.



### Lawn App #4

We have officially started lawn app #4, which contains the WEED CONTROL you've been waiting for. Along with that weed control, it also contains liquid iron, which will help balance out the color of the grass and make it more green and less yellow. Please remember that this weed control only treats for broadleaf weeds. If our technician sees more aggressive weeds outside of the broadleaf family, we will send a separate estimate to treat those. If your property has a history of issues with these more aggressive weeds such as kyllinga and sedge, consider upgrading to our Premium Monthly Program, which includes treatments for these weeds. Please allow the treatment 2-3 weeks to take effect after it is applied. You will not see weeds disappear instantly.

### IRRIGATION

We have been fortunate to have gotten some significant rainfall to help alleviate some of the extreme dryness from the drought we have been experiencing. This rainfall has been long overdue and much needed. At this time, you can dial back to 3-5 days a week watering schedule now if you have been doing daily watering previously. Most yards are recovering from the drought stress with the rain we've received.

Remember that watering times and schedules vary depending upon what soil type your property has. Clay or gumbo soils can withstand less watering, whereas sandy or well drained soils need more watering.

### TRANSITIONING

By now, most turf have transitioned out of dormancy.


There is a lot of centipede turf that has sustained winter kill. If you are seeing bare areas or areas that have not transitioned and appear dead, we can resod those areas for you. Please call the office for an estimate to resod.

When we recommend getting a fungicide in the fall to lessen the severity of winter kill, this is what we are referring to. That fungicide helps to strengthen those areas that are more susceptible to winter kill.
