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
ABOUT

OUR CAPABILITIES



GENERAL PLUMBING & GAS

Comprehensive, full-service plumbing and gas fitting services. Covering compressed air systems, hot water systems, firefighting systems, hydrant flow testing and maintenance, as well as backflow assessments, testing, servicing and more.



WATER SUPPLY, FILTRATION & TREATMENT

Specialists in RO water filter units, water sterilisation and filtration systems, and oil/water treatment systems for residential, commercial and industrial applications.



WASTE & ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES

Comprehensive waste management including sewerage and grease trap pump outs and maintenance, wastewater removal via vacuum truck, and oil/water treatment solutions.



BORE & PUMP SYSTEMS

Supply, installation, repair and maintenance of solar and electric bore equipment, groundwater and sewer pumps, and associated pumping systems.



CIVIL & INFRASTRUCTURE

Capability in poly welding, confined space entry, high-risk machine operation, excavations, concrete cutting, rock breaking and removal for civil and infrastructure projects.



PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE

Scheduled servicing and inspections to prevent breakdowns, extend asset life, and ensure compliance, covering plumbing, gas, pumps and filtration systems.

Plant and equipment wet hire including bore equipment, hydrovac trucks, backhoes, skidsteer, tipper trucks, crane truck and excavators, with skilled operators for project support.

MUNGKARTA HOUSING UPGRADE

Client: NT Government Department of Housing, Local Government, Community Development
Year: 2025 | **Value:** \$3.5M

The Mungkarta Housing Upgrade ensured safe, culturally appropriate housing for an Aboriginal homeland. This project addresses the unique challenges of remote delivery through planning, strong community engagement, and local capability building.

Scope:

- Deliver safe and culturally appropriate housing for the Mungkarta Aboriginal homeland, 80 km south of Tennant Creek.
- Manage remote logistics, workforce challenges, and community engagement to ensure successful delivery.

Outcome:

Safe, modern housing delivered on time and on budget, with strong community collaboration and sustainable local capability built for long-term benefit.



NEW WIITIN BORE

Client: NT Government Department of Housing, Local Government, Community Development
Year: 2025 | **Value:** \$150K

The New Wiitin Bore project allowed Territory Water Solutions to provide the Wiitin community with a reliable water source in one of the Northern Territory's most remote regions. This critical work ensured long-term water security through careful planning and culturally respectful engagement.

Scope:

- Drill and install a fit-for-purpose bore to meet the community's immediate and long-term water needs.
- Overcome remote delivery challenges, including logistics, subcontractor management, and community consultation.

Outcome:

A fully operational bore delivering sustainable water supply, completed on time and in collaboration with the local community.



MUNGKARTA WATER UPGRADE

Client: Yapa-Kurlangu Ngurrara Aboriginal Corporation | **Year:** 2025 | **Value:** \$240K

The Mungkarta Water Upgrade involved installing a new water line for the local bore, ensuring reliable water access for the community. This work required careful planning to maintain service continuity and overcome the challenges of remote delivery.

Scope:

- Install a water line for the bore while maintaining uninterrupted water supply for residents.
- Overcome remote project challenges through logistics planning, multi-skilled teams, and strong community engagement.

Outcome:

A fully operational water line installed safely and efficiently, with minimal disruption and long-term reliability for the community.



NEWCASTLE WATERS SOFTENER SYSTEM UPGRADE

Client: Aboriginal Enterprises Australia NT
Year: 2023 | **Value:** \$180K

The Newcastle Waters project redesigned critical water infrastructure to ensure reliable supply, safely managing logistics and engaging the community.

Scope:

- Redesign water infrastructure for the Newcastle Waters community to ensure reliable supply during power outages.
- Manage safe trenching, large tank logistics, and oversize transport while engaging respectfully with local stakeholders.

Outcome:

Reliable water supply delivered through a redesigned system with backup capacity, completed safely and efficiently, with strong community collaboration and lasting benefits.



NYINKKA NYUNYU ARTS AND CULTURE CENTER WATER UPGRADE

Client: ANT NT Pty Ltd | **Year:** 2024
Value: \$250K

The Nyinkka Nyunyu refurbishment project overcame documentation challenges and complex coordination to deliver safe, efficient upgrades with lasting community benefit.

Scope:

- Deliver refurbishment works at Nyinkka Nyunyu while protecting existing in-ground services and ensuring safe upgrades.
- Manage documentation inconsistencies, shifting subcontractor timelines, and on-site coordination challenges in a remote location.

Outcome:

Safe refurbishment works delivered through detailed planning and documentation review, completed efficiently and without service disruptions, with proactive collaboration and stakeholder engagement ensuring quality results and lasting benefit.



CANTEEN CREEK TANK

Client: NT Government Department of Infrastructure, Planning & Logistics (as part of 12 month Repair and Maintenance Contract)
Year: 2025 | **Value:** \$282K

The Canteen Creek project resolved persistent water pressure issues and compliance risks to deliver a safer, more reliable supply.

Scope:

- Install a dedicated 10,000-litre water tank and pressure pump system to restore reliable water pressure.
- Manage remote workforce logistics, skilled trade availability, and compliance challenges while supporting local engagement.

Outcome:

Reliable water supply delivered through a new tank and pump system, completed safely and efficiently, with strong workforce capability and community support ensuring lasting benefits.
