On February 20th, Paul, alongside clients and friends witnessed the ancient custom of the Ceremony of the Keys, the formal locking of the Tower Of London's gates.


This ceremony has occurred every night, without fail since the year 1340. In a world that is fast paced and ever changing, it's nice to know that some things never change.


Weather permitting the first home game will be on the 13th of April, albeit this will be just a warmup friendly. The all-important Essex league fixtures will begin early May.


