

New Government, Old HR Regulations

Despite the recent Labour victory, it's important not to overlook the pending HR regulations introduced by the previous Conservative government.

Soon, employers will need to adhere to new dismissal and re-engagement guidelines, commonly known as 'fire and rehire'. Starting last week, additional procedural steps will be required. Failing to comply with these steps and facing a tribunal claim could lead to higher compensation pay-outs.

Furthermore, beginning on Saturday, 26th October, employers will have new responsibilities to prevent sexual harassment in the workplace.

Employees will have the ability to report inadequate preventive measures to the Equality and Human Rights Commission, regardless of whether any harassment allegations exist.

Even after these laws are enacted, they may be subject to changes or amendments by the new Labour government, so stay tuned for potential updates. For assistance in implementing these upcoming changes in your organisation, reach out to Bradley & Co.
