Congratulations, Glen!



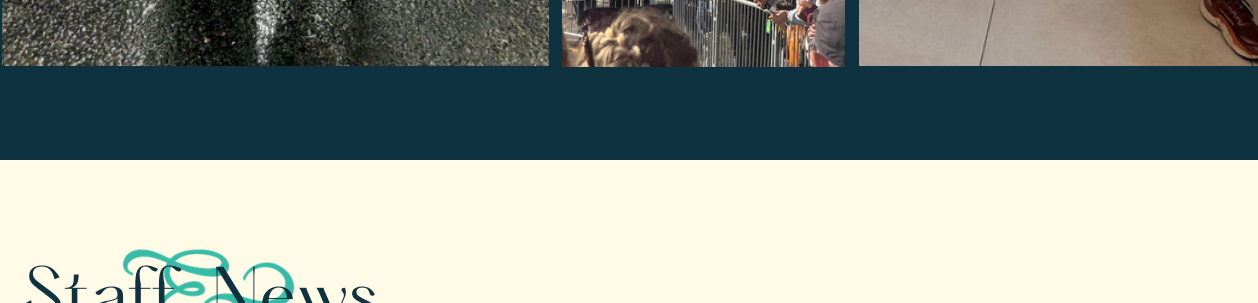
This month, a huge congratulations goes to our very own Glen Herron for completing the London Landmarks Half Marathon in support of the incredible charity, Grief Encounter.

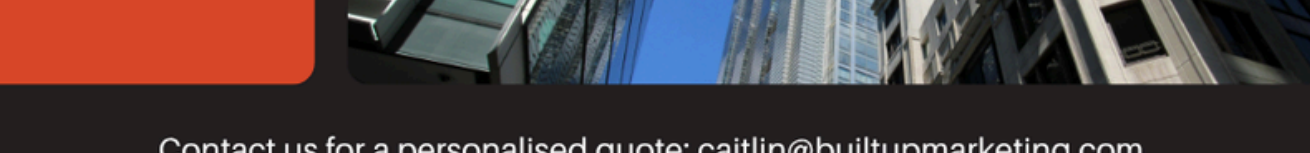
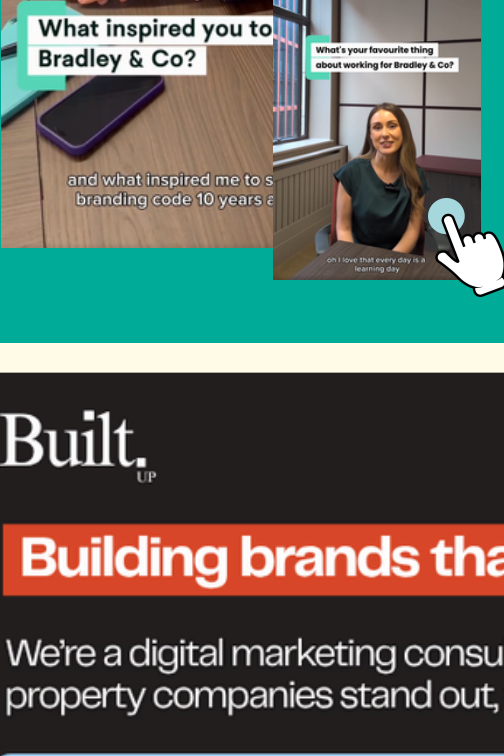


Lights, Camera, Action

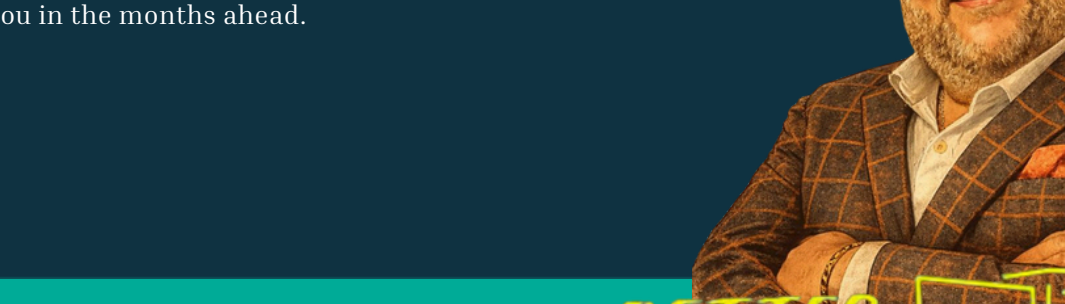


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A Word From Paul...
