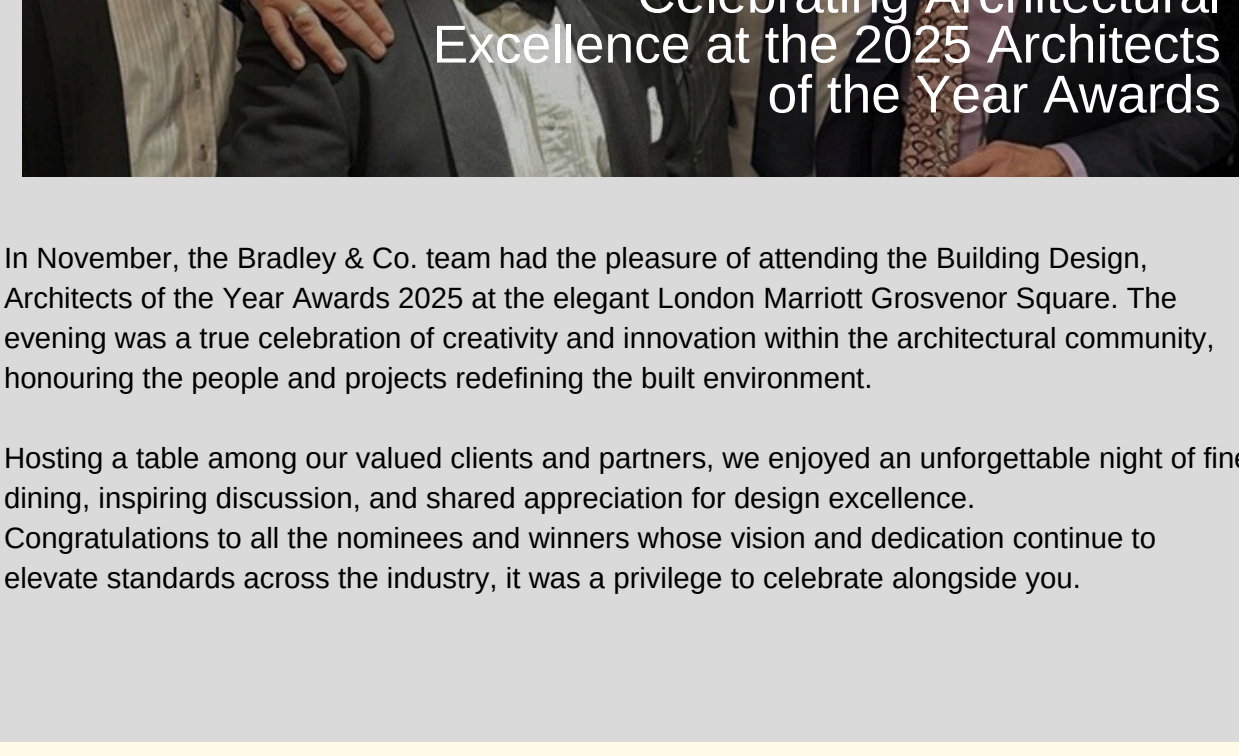
## Industry Awards 2025

Here's to another successful collaboration and a continued commitment to service excellence across our portfolio.

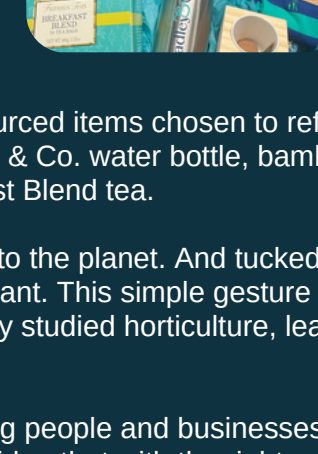
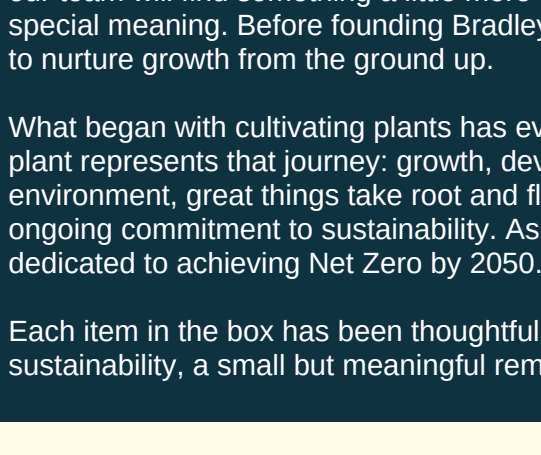


### Christmas Jumper Day

Thank you once again for a wonderful day, we look forward to many more shared moments in 2026.

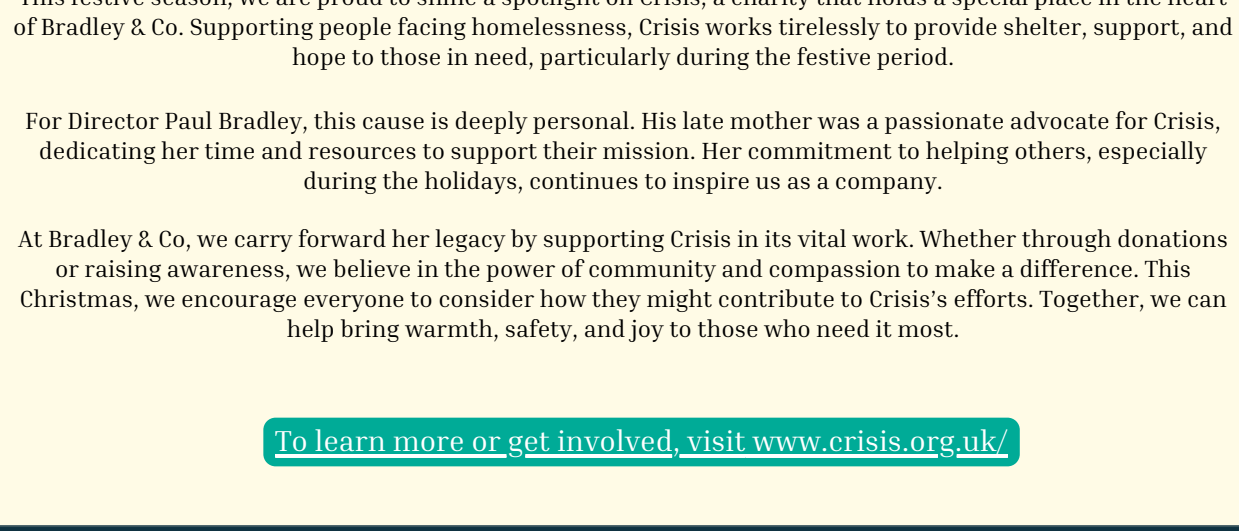
