Bachelor of Commerce in Digital Business

The programme is delivered over six semesters across three years. You will complete eight fundamental modules in Year One and eight core modules in each of Years Two and Three. All modules must be successfully completed to be awarded the degree.

Assessment combines formative (60%) and summative (40%), including essays, projects, presentations, group work, and reflective analysis.

Graduates may progress to the Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) in Digital Business or enter roles such as administration, project support, finance, and business analysis.

Assessment combines formative (60%) and summative (40%), including essays, projects, presentations, group work, and reflective analysis.

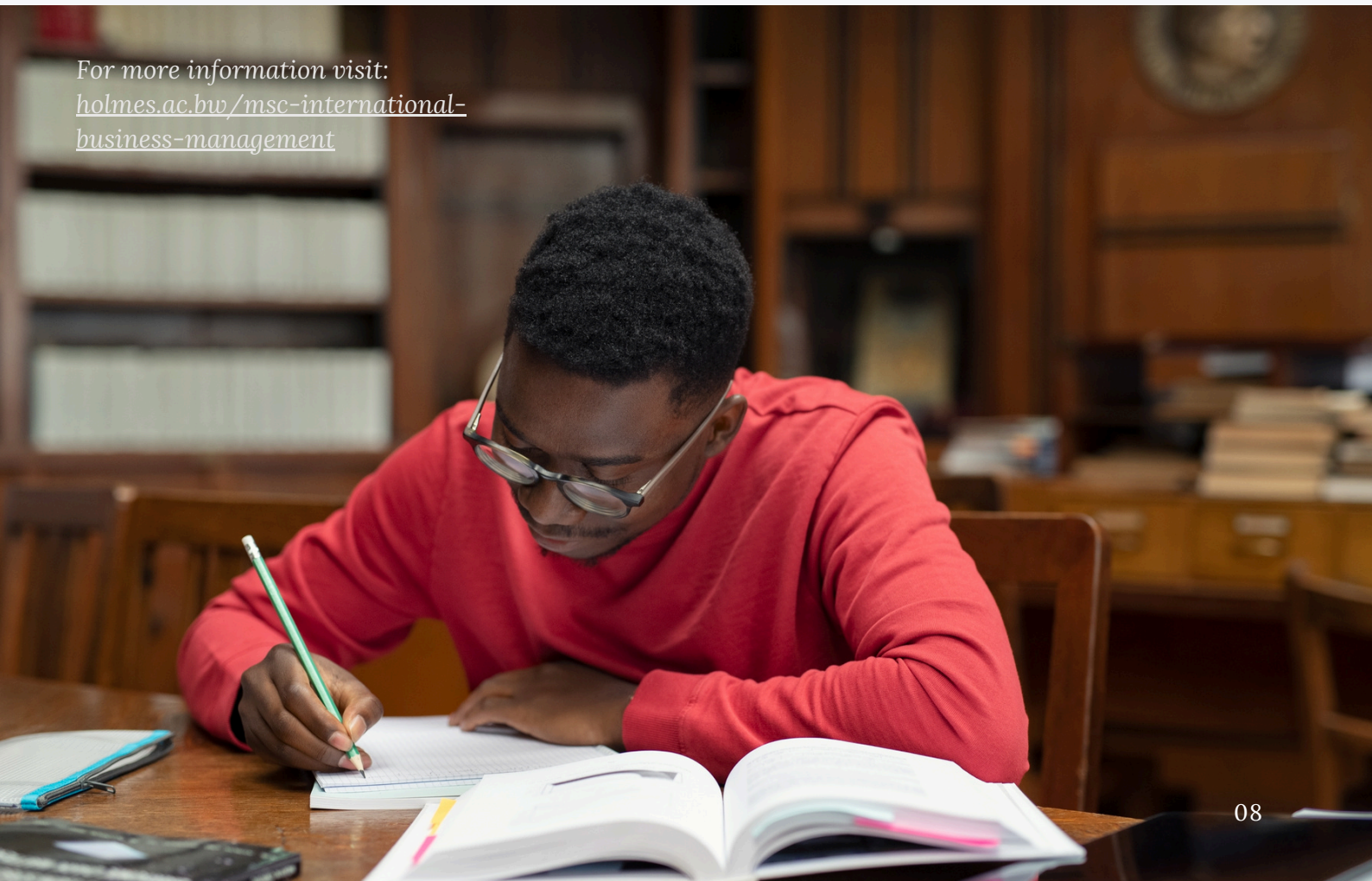


