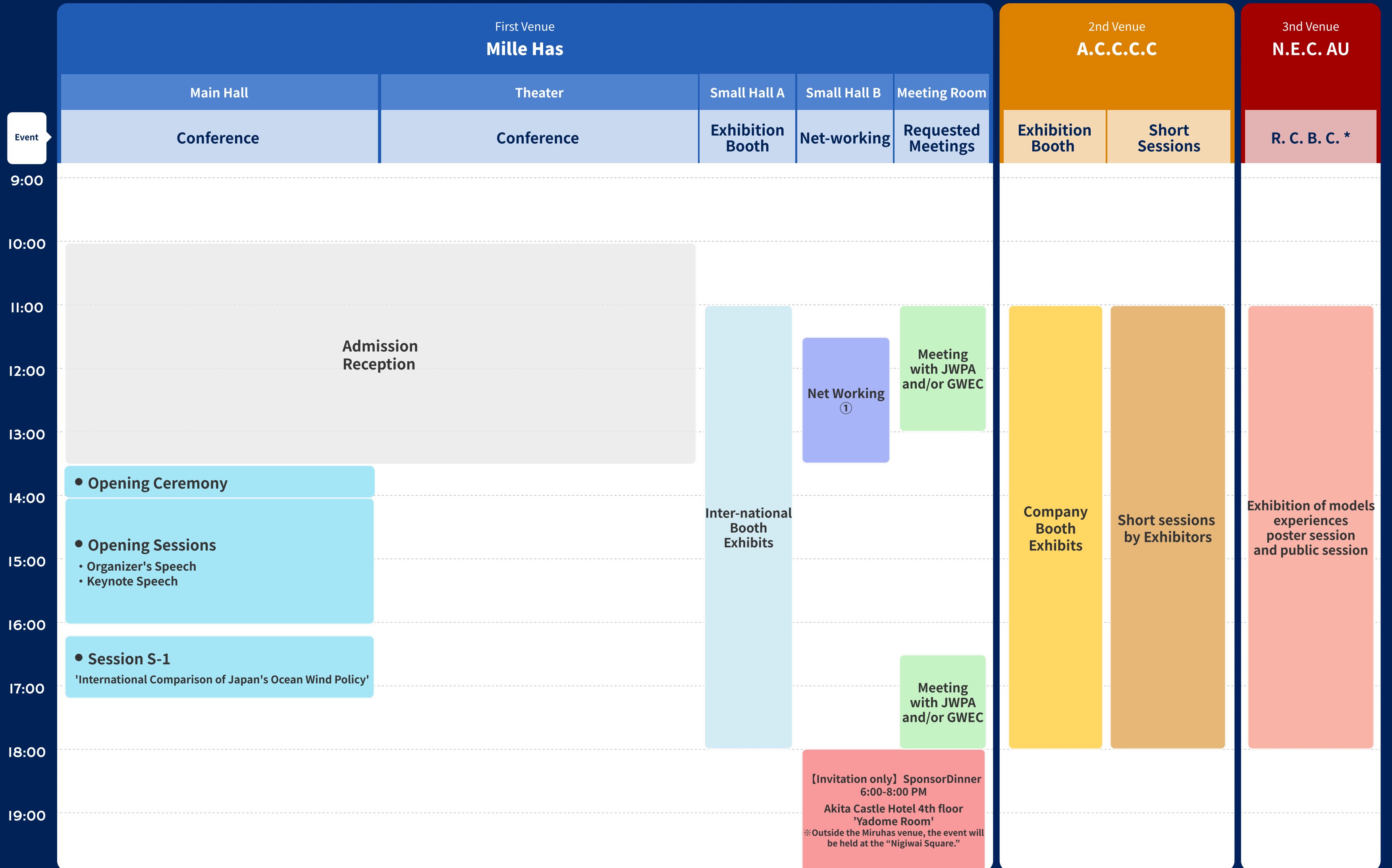

1. The conference will take place in the Main Hall (Large hall) and Theatre (middle hall) of Mille Has Venue. To attend the conference, you will need a conference ticket (Type A, Type B or One day ticket), a sponsor ticket or a speaker ticket.
2. The International Booth will be located near the entrance on the first floor of Mille Has. Corporate booths will be set up in Hall A on the 4th floor of Miruhas and on the 2nd floor of Akita City Cultural Creation Center. Admission to these booth exhibition areas is free.
3. Each networking opportunity will be hosted by the embassy that will have a booth. In addition to sessions by cluster companies, there will be two hours of networking time with light refreshments. They will be held twice, on October 15 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and on the 16th from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.
4. The Community Consensus Building Corner is an exhibition hall aimed at community stakeholders and students. There will be model and poster displays, an experience corner related to wind power generation, as well as public and academic sessions. The Regional Consensus Building Corner is hosted by the host local government and co-hosted by JWPA.
5. During the event, participating organizations (institutions, embassies, companies) can request individual meetings with the organizers, JWPA or GWEC. Each meeting will be private and will last no more than 45 minutes.
