

GOWS-J 2026 Open Seminar Room Terms and Conditions

Article 1 (Purpose)

These Terms and Conditions set forth the rules governing the use of meeting rooms made available for a fee for seminars and similar events (the “Open Seminars”) organized by companies or organizations during the Global Offshore Wind Summit–Japan 2026 (“GOWS-J 2026”).

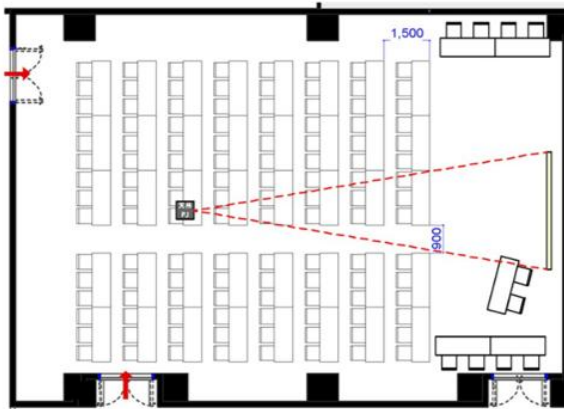
Article 2 (Eligibility)

1. Open Seminars may be organized only by GOWS-J sponsors, exhibitors, and non-profit organizations or public institutions participating in GOWS-J, subject to approval by the Organizer.
2. Attendance at Open Seminars shall be free of charge. Organizers may invite GOWS-J participants as well as members of the public, including students, at their discretion.
3. Available venues are Meeting Room 107 or Meeting Room 108 at Dejima Messe Nagasaki, the official venue of GOWS-J 2026.

Article 3 (Conditions of Use)

1. Seminar rooms may be reserved in one-hour units between 9:00 and 17:00 on each day from 13 to 15 October 2026. Reservations exceeding one hour may be extended in 30-minute increments.
2. The rental fee is JPY 110,000 (tax included) per hour. Each additional 30 minutes is JPY 55,000 (tax included).
3. The rental fee includes the following equipment provided with the venue:
 - 40 tables
 - 120 chairs
 - One screen and projector set
 - Two microphones

Any additional equipment shall be arranged and paid for by the Organizer.



4. If interpretation services are required, the Organizer shall arrange and bear the cost of consecutive interpretation. Simultaneous interpretation is not available due to venue limitations.

Article 4 (Application and Payment)

1. Applications shall be submitted directly through the system designated by the Organizer. If approval under Article 2(1) is not granted within two weeks after application, the application will automatically be cancelled.

2. Rental fees will be invoiced by the Organizer or the Event Secretariat after the Open Seminar. The Organizer shall pay the full amount no later than **15 November 2026**.

3. Cancellations are accepted without charge only if written notice is received no later than 11 September 2026. After this date, the full rental fee shall remain payable regardless of whether the seminar is held.

Article 5 (Organizer Responsibilities)

Organizers shall: comply with the reserved time; complete participant changeover within the 30-minute interval; in principle, restore the room layout to its original condition within the reserved time if any tables, chairs, or other equipment have been rearranged; manage registration and participant guidance; avoid damaging or losing facilities, equipment, fixtures, or furnishings; and be responsible for safeguarding their own valuables.

The Organizer and the owners/managers of Dejima Messe Nagasaki shall not be liable for losses arising from violations of these Terms. Users shall compensate for damage caused to facilities or equipment.

Article 6 (Prohibited Activities)

Without prior approval, the following are prohibited: displays, sales activities or fundraising; bringing in food or beverages not declared; smoking; use of undeclared equipment; hazardous materials; attaching items to walls or pillars; damaging furniture; distributing flyers or placing signs on the venue premises; political or religious activities; commercial sales unrelated to the event; and any conduct that disturbs other users.

Article 7 (Restriction or Cancellation of Use)

The Organizer may cancel or suspend use if the reservation is transferred to a third party, these Terms are violated, activities are contrary to public order and morals, the Organizer is associated with anti-social forces, or the Organizer fails to follow instructions. In such cases, the rental fee remains payable.

Article 8 (Promotion)

The Organizer will publicize approved Open Seminars on the official GOWS-J website and in the event program. Seminar organizers may also promote their seminars independently before and during the event.

Article 9 (Personal Information)

Personal information obtained by the Organizer shall be handled in accordance with the JWPA Privacy Policy and shall not be disclosed to third parties without the prior consent of the relevant organizer.

Article 10 (Supplementary Provisions)

Matters not stipulated herein shall be governed by the facility rules of Dejima Messe Nagasaki.
