STRAKER COOKIES POLICY

Background

This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are and how we use them. You should read this policy to understand what cookies are, how we use them, the types of cookies we use i.e., the information we collect using cookies and how that information is used and how to control the cookie preferences. What are Cookies?

Cookies are small files that store information on your computer, mobile phone or other device. They enable the entity that puts the cookie on your device to recognise you across different websites, services, devices and / or browsing sessions. You may be able to disable cookies through your internet browser but allowing us to collect cookies ensures that the Straker website (**Site**) works as intended. However, you are free to control your cookie preferences. (See below).

How do we use Cookies?

As most online services, our Site uses first-party and third-party cookies for a number of purposes.

First-party cookies are created by the website you're visiting - in this case our Site. The web browser will send a request in a process that provides the highest level of trust that you are, as the user, directly interacting with Straker. The web browser saves this data file to your computer under our Domain. These cookies allow Straker to collect analytics data, remember language settings, and perform other useful functions that provide you with a good user experience. For example, if you were to block first-party cookies every time you visited our Site, you would have to sign in every single time you visited our Site, which may not be a very pleasant experience. However the choice is yours.

Third-party cookies are cookies that are set by a website other than the one you are currently on i.e., cookies that are stored under a different Domain. These are usually used for online-advertising purposes and are placed on our Site (with our consent) through adding scripts or tags. Online advertising is the most common use of third-party cookies. Please note that by adding their tags to a page on our Site, which may or may not display adverts, advertisers can track you (or your device/s) across many of the websites you visit. Please see below on how to manage your cookie preference when on our Site.

How can you control your Cookie preferences?

You can manage your cookies preferences by clicking on the Show Details link and enabling or disabling the cookie categories on the popup according to your preferences.

Should you decide to change your preferences later through your browsing session, you can click on the Cookies Preferences link in the Site footer. This will display the consent notice again enabling you to change your preferences or withdraw your consent entirely.
