1. Introduction

- 1.1. The Data Protection Policy and the Legal Notice apply in their entirety to this document. The definitions set forth in the Legal Notice are hereby incorporated by reference and shall apply throughout this document.

2. What Are Cookies

- 2.1. Cookies are small text files stored on your device when you visit a website. They help us remember your preferences, improve your browsing experience, and analyze how you interact with our website. Some cookies are essential for the website's functionality, while others are used for analytical purposes.

3. How We Use Cookies

- 3.1. We use cookies for different purposes, such as:
 - Essential Cookies: Necessary for the website to function properly.
 - Analytics Cookies: Help us understand how visitors interact with our website, such as which pages are the most popular.
 - In some special cases, these are third-party cookies provided by trusted third parties.
- 3.2. We use Google Analytics to collect usage statistics to improve our website's performance and user experience.

uc_session	Session	This cookie is set by Dropbox and is used for the 'save to Dropbox' functionality. This cookie stores user session IDs.
__cfuid	Session	Calendly sets this cookie to track users across sessions to optimize user experience by maintaining session consistency and providing personalized services.
rc::a	Never expires	This cookie is set by the Google reCAPTCHA service to identify bots to protect the

rc::c	Session	website against malicious spam attacks. This cookie is set by the Google reCAPTCHA service to identify bots to protect the website against malicious spam attacks.
cookieyes-consent	1 year	CookieYes sets this cookie to remember users' consent preferences so that their preferences are respected on subsequent visits to this site. It does not collect or store any personal information about the site visitors.
ga*	1 year, 1 month, and 4 days	Google Analytics sets this cookie to store and count page views.
_ga	1 year, 1 month, and 4 days	Google Analytics sets this cookie to calculate visitor, session, and campaign data and track site usage for the site's analytics report. The cookie stores information anonymously and assigns a randomly generated number to recognize unique visitors.

4. Google Analytics

- 4.1. We use Google Analytics to collect information about how users interact with our website. This helps us analyze data to improve the user experience and optimize our content.
