BUILDING PROJECT:

Good news! We aim to start the work in September and we are busy applying for grants to aid the work.

The approval of the diocese for our building project covers part 1: Renovation of the Church and basic work on the Old School House. The new confessionals and baptistery will be in part 2. We wish, however, to start fundraising for particular parts of the project: in particular the Icon of Our Lady £25,000
