- **Organizational and Cultural Transformation**

Submission guidelines

- **Abstract length:** maximum 500 words
- **Submission deadline:** 15 May 2026

Accepted contributions will be presented as short 10-minute presentations, followed by moderated discussion. Abstracts will be reviewed by the CLAIR Scientific Committee.

Review criteria

- **Relevance to one or more of CLAIR's core themes**
- **Conceptual clarity and analytical rigor**
- **Contribution to understanding AI's implications for research, engineering or innovation**
- **Explicit consideration of organizational, leadership, or governance context in R&D-intensive environments**
- **Cross-industry relevance and potential to stimulate reflective dialogue**
