SAFELY SECURING YOUR WASTE

in preparation for collection

It is crucial to ensure all bagged waste is safely and securely contained before it can be collected by your waste technician. To assist with this and provide accurate waste tracking information you will need to clearly identify your waste prior to collection using unique coded bag ties.

THE SWAN-NECK METHOD

1



When the bag is filled $\frac{3}{4}$ full, twist the excess at the top of the bag

2



Double over and twist firmly...

3



Securely fasten the bag knotting the twisted neck of the bag or by passing a unique coded cable tie over the twisted neck

4



Ensure the unique coded cable tie it is fastened tightly to create an effective seal.



Bags should be filled no more than two thirds OR to a maximum weight of 5kg, whichever is reached first. **PLEASE DO NOT OVERFILL THE BAGS**



Do not use for the disposal of free liquids.



Do not use for the disposal sharps or rigid items likely to puncture the bag.
