Sensory Programs

At Swann Special Care, we prioritize respect and enrichment for every individual. Our sensory programs enable residents to engage their senses and interact meaningfully with their environment. Through music, art projects, cooking, and interactive sensory spaces, we offer opportunities for exploration and self-expression.

Sensory programs provide a multitude of benefits, including promoting relaxation, enhancing social interactions, and supporting cognitive development. By integrating these programs into daily living and learning environments, we create invaluable opportunities for growth and discovery.



Specialized Care

Our community offers support for individuals with complex medical and developmental needs, including those affected by genetic disorders, trauma, or debilitating illnesses. With a skilled nursing team comprised of RNs, LPNs, CNAs, DSPs, and Case Managers, we provide compassionate care in a safe, home-like environment.

Community Day School

The Community Day School at Swann Center is a non-public private school that provides year-round educational services to students between ages 3 and 21 who have severe and profound disabilities and medical needs.

Our mission is to promote learning, dignity and quality of life for students in an environment that furthers individuality.



Day Training Program

Our Day Training Program focuses on the development and enhancement of daily adaptive living skills, such as motor skills, range of motion, cognitive awareness, communication and activities of daily living. Open to residents of the greater community as well as those residing at Swann, Day Training operates 255 days a year from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Team members are highly qualified to support residents' needs. Program development and oversight is provided by full-time Qualified Intellectual Disability Professionals (QIDPs). Individualized Program Plans are implemented by certified Direct Support Professionals (DSPs). Specialized adaptive equipment is also available to enhance the learning process.
