We had 3,744 participant opportunities for children, 215 for youth and 722 for adults and seniors, in over 400 program hours.

Program Highlights


Allan Gardens welcomed us back in spring, giving us a place to start our seedlings with school groups. Big thanks to [Friends of Allan Gardens!](#) We also held our annual [Spring is In the Air](#) event with live music, plant sale, face painting, silent auction and kids' activities, in April.



We continued our [Urban Trees from Seed](#) program, thanks to the [Urban Forestry Department of the City of Toronto](#), with new or expanded tree nursery locations at all of our school garden sites. We are excited for the future of these trees, as part of the City's goal of getting to 40% canopy cover from the current 26%. Species include Red Oak, Kentucky Coffeetree and Pawpaw.

We continued programming at three primary schools, Rose Ave PS, Winchester JSPS and Sprucecourt PS. We also supplied programming to Frankland PS, George Webster PS, Forest Valley PS, Morse Street Jr. PS, Nelson Mandela Park PS, St. Maria Goretti PS (TCDSB), and Thorncliffe Park PS. Many programs were part of [Teaming With Life](#), (photo right) a new program, which introduced a microscope and a worm bin for elementary students, made possible by funding from [Telus](#). Thanks to our Teaming With Life contractors for making this a popular program!

We had post-secondary students from Toronto Metropolitan University learning in hands-on programs at Winchester JSPS and Rose Ave PS (photo right), from classes in the Early Childhood Education department such as Children and Nature (undergraduate) and Ecological Curriculum, Pedagogy, and Research (graduate).

School Gardens Land Back training program completed 2 full cohorts in the fall of 2023 and spring of 2024. We had the pleasure of learning with Indigenous mentors Jim Adams, Carolynne Crawley of Msit N'kmaq, Chef Johl Ringuette and Isaac Crosby of Crosby Gitigaan, in programs managed by Megan Bennett, funded by the [Canadian Red Cross](#). This program allowed 20 community members, mostly parents, to learn all about school gardens by participating as volunteers as well as joining in classroom and virtual learning time. The long-term goal of this program is to support a network of school gardens and gardeners, informed by Indigenous mentors.

This section of Winchester JSPS Public School Garden is slated for renovation in 2025. We hope that the trees will survive a move. The overall capital project will add a soccer pitch or two to the school grounds. These food beds were getting shaded anyway, so we'll move the sun-loving beds to the southeast of the garden area. We plan to re-engage students in the garden as soon as possible!
